

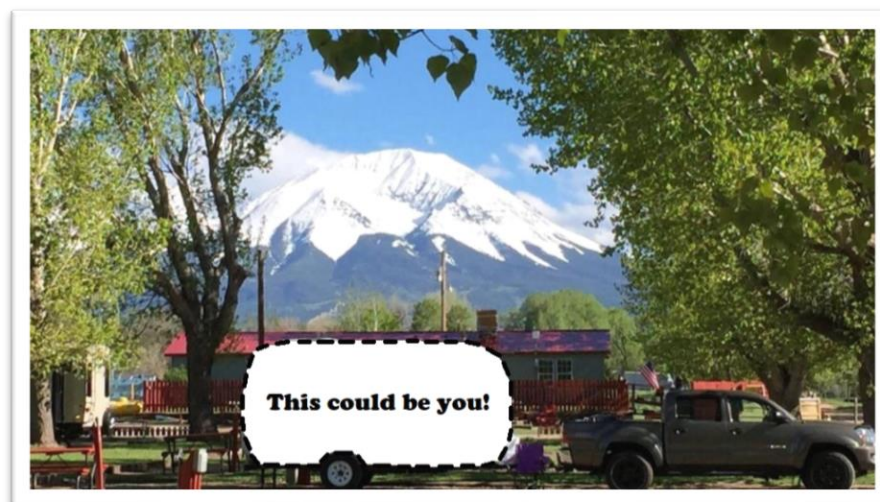
La Veta Circle the Wagons RV Park Rally

The Circle the Wagons RV park features shaded spots and many local attractions, such as; the Highway of Legends, Le Veta Trails, Mountain lakes, Cuchara, Lathrop State Park, the Rio Grande Scenic Railway, and the Great Sand Dunes. The weekend of the rally will coincide with the Stonewall Century Ride, a 100-mile bicycling fundraiser event for fire fighters. Volunteers and riders are welcome and the event has a traditional hootenanny that will take place Saturday afternoon with live music.
