Come and join us at our rally site on the Bob Heward Ranch near Medicine Bow, Wyoming. This will be our 66th Annual Antelope Rally.

Presently, the cook shack and storage shed and supplies are on our site. Dry camping with a portapoty, we'll have electricity on a first come basis available. Bring extension cords, Water will be at the cook shack.

If you would like to help put on any events for our programs, please volunteer. Expect to have a good meal provided by the Wyoming unit and all can bring breakfast supplies to the cook shack too. We will have a crock pot night. Bring your crock pot.

Some fun events and of course—excellent antelope hunting if you draw a tag. There are Hot Springs in Saratoga ....... bring the swim suit.

Applications for antelope licenses may be obtained online, http:/gf.state.wy.us or by calling 1-800-842-1934 or 1-307-777-4600. Application period starts January 2nd, 2020. The deadline for nonresident hunters is May 31, 2020; results of the draw should be out by June 20<sup>th</sup> 2020, so don't delay. If you are unsuccessful in the drawing, check back with Game and Fish for the availability of leftover licenses. Your first choice should be area 47. This area takes in the 60,000-acre; Heward Ranch has allowed us to hunt on this ranch for many years. For second and third choices we suggest areas 46 and 48.

Fishermen try nearby Lake Allen which has some excellent trout fishing. Bring your pole! Available at sporting good stores; purchase one day or more out of state fishing licenses once you're in the state.

Please sign up early to assist in the planning of the rally. Use coupon in this issue of The "Blue Beret" to register. The registration fee will be \$85 per person through September 10 and \$95 per person after September 10<sup>th</sup>. Cancellations will be refundable up to the September 10<sup>th</sup> date. If you are unsuccessful and do not draw an antelope license, there is a lot of country to explore.

The location of our site is about 3 miles east of Medicine Bow on Highways 30 and 287 past the large "Heward 25 Ranch sign coming from Medicine Bow. Turn left after crossing Medicine Bow River. Coming from the east turn in to the right (north) just before the Medicine Bow River.
