Dear Committee Members:

Over our many years of participating in WBCCI rallies and caravans, we have begun to notice subtle friction pertaining to the subject of prayer before meals or gatherings. This past year, we witnessed one airstream participant express his desire to discontinue the practice of prayer before group meals, to be replaced by a moment of silence, whereby those who wished to pray before meals might do so silently. His argument in favor of his suggestion was that he and several others on that particular caravan were non-religious and did not wish to be subjected to religious practices of others.

Given the fact that WBCCI caravans should be nonsectarian in every respect, we salute the bravery of this Airstreamer who spoke up about this to the entire caravan. Unfortunately, we witnessed a distinct coolness toward him and his spouse for the remaining duration of this particular caravan and several future attempts by others in this caravan to re-insert prayer in group activities.

We believe that WBCCI should remedy this situation by discontinuing the practice of prayer at any group meals or activities as being inappropriate to the mission of a caravan. Recent research online has produced statistics which I found surprising. Of the world's 5 largest religions (Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Islam and Judaism), 2.1 billion are Christians, however 1.1 billion are non-religious. For people who do not believe in religion, it is offensive to be subjected to the prayers of others while on a recreational activity for which they have paid money.

Please give this request for development of a definite policy eliminating religious activities of any denomination as part of any WBCCI caravan/rally activity your consideration. It is a problem that is increasingly driving a wedge between folks on caravans who wish only to have a good time. Thank you.

Due to the possibility of possible recriminations towards us on future WBCCI activities, I will not divulge my identity. Please understand.
