President Cecelia Stansbury called our annual meeting to order with all Clubs represented. Everybody knows that money comes in and out when we are supporting the Region Rally, the Rose Parade Rally and the International Board of Trustees, or 2020 Mid-Winter Rally. As of June 30, 2019, we had balances totaling \$52,286.00.

Cecelia urged all clubs to be vigilant as there is a scam currently operating that aims at us. Two of our clubs were victimized to the tune of \$3,800.00 each. Each club should ensure there are at least two officers designated to approve all disbursement of funds.

Don Williams, our outgoing Membership chair, was thanked for all his years of service. During his tenure, our Region has been awarded two International Club awards for membership growth. At this meeting we welcomed our new Membership Chair, Nancy Murphy, of the Greater Los Angeles Airstream Club.

LaVerne McHenry, 1st Vice President, reported on the Region 12 breakfast in Doswell, Virginia. She then introduced a Motion which was unanimously passed on formally adopting the Region 12 logo. Policy 6 can be found on our Region's website. President Stansbury shared that the Stansbury/ Smithson team will end their operation of the 38year-old Rose Parade Rally in 2020/21. She has requested to have one of our 11 clubs to step up and take over the reins of this popular event.

Eric McHenry, International 3rd Vice President, reported on several plans that are in the works with the Executive Committee.

- Partnering with companies like Harvest Hosts;
- Visiting future International Rally sites in Colorado (2020); Tennessee (2021); and a possible site in Maine (2022);
- Future club activities should be entered on the WBCCI master calendar;
- Changes that will give each WBCCI member a vote rather than one vote per Airstream;
- Changes to Members at Large.

The 2020 Region 12 Rally will be held October 21-25 at the Emerald Desert RV Resort in Palm Desert, CA, hosted by the San Diego Unit.

The meeting was closed following Cecelia's request for 2nd Vice President candidates and a discussion about a possible motion to adopt official Region 12 colors.

Our WBCCI family lost an amazing member with the passing of Barb Wharton Selking on October 24. A member of the North Texas Unit, Barb served in many capacities throughout her time in our club, most recently as International Secretary. A friend to all, her smile simply illuminated every International Rally.

It was a thrill to meet Phil Noyes, Los Angeles producer/director of the popular Huell Howser PBS series and author of 'Trailerama', a staple in any vintage trailer owner's library. On stage, Noyes interviewed Johnny Agnew of Funky Junk Farms, another well-known vintage trailer restorer, who not only worked to preserve LA's Monterey Trailer Park, but helped to see it achieve monument status on the Los Angeles register of Historic-Cultural Monuments. The 1.7 acre site near Los Angeles began in the early 1920s when Americans were traveling the United States without the luxury of hotels.

An exciting 'first' for everyone attending was to meet and listen to the leaders of the three largest trailer/RV organizations in the world. Mona Heath, International President of the WBCCI, the longest rolling, single-branded RV club in the world; Maurrie Sussman, Sister #1 of Sisters On The Fly, the largest women's outdoor adventure organization in the U.S.; and Forrest Bone of the Tin Can Tourists organization, founded in 1919.
