Tech tip:

Over 1600 members have signed up for next summer's 63rd International Rally in Loveland, Colorado. The rally runs from 20 – 27 June 2020 at the Ranch Event Complex in Loveland. For those going to Colorado, the rally committee is already posting information and updates online (*loveland.airstreamclub.net*). One of the key concerns voiced by several has been with power. Loveland will provide 20 AMP and water to all rigs. This means everyone will have to manage power consumption throughout the rally to prevent problems. Per the Rally Team, you will not be able to run you're A/C even with a Micro Air Easy Start system. More details & information (aka the "Principle of 7") are available at the Loveland website. Loveland is ~5000 feet elevation and should have somewhat cooler temps that we had in Virginia this past July, but, if you plan to run your AC, you will have to move to the Personal General Section. Deadline to shift your site to the Generator section is 18 December 2019.
