

WBCCI Name Badge Color Coding

Color coded Name Badges are authorized for wear as follows. Each Name Badge may use one of the three approved WBCCI Logos (see Logo Option area within this document).

International President / Royal Blue with Gold

International Presidents and Past Presidents and their spouses.



International Officer / Royal Blue with White

Present and Past International 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Vice Presidents, Corporate Managers, Recording Secretaries, Treasurers, Parliamentarians, Executive Secretaries, the Honorary Corresponding Secretary and their spouses.



Region President / Red and Silver with White

Present and Past Region Presidents and their spouses.



Region Vice President / Red with White

Region Vice Presidents and their spouses.



International Standing Committee Chair / Coral with White

International Standing Committee Chairmen and their spouses.



Local Club President / Milk-White with Light Blue

Present and Past Unit Presidents and their spouses.



Local Club Officer and Officials / White

To be worn by Local Club officials. These badges may have their current Club role displayed on the badge (Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership, Webmaster, etc).



Caravan Leader / White with Light Green

Caravan Leaders, Assistant Caravan Leaders and spouses of numbered National, Region and Overseas caravans. The badge will be issued by the Caravan Standing Committee Chair.



General Member / White

To be worn by all general Club members.



Logo Option:

Each Name Badge may use one of the three approved WBCCI Logos:

Airstream Club International (ACI) logo



This new logo was developed as part of the WBCCI rebranding project in 2019. The goals of the redesign was to modernize all elements of the Club communications material, including website, logos, membership material, etc After early 2020, members of WBCCI have the ACI logo as one of their choices on their name badges, club merchandise and trailer decals.

Heritage Wally Byam Caravan Club International (WBCCI) logo



This logo was one of the original WBCCI logos highlighting founder Wally Byam and the signature caravans available through the Club. This logo was first introduced in the 1950's and used as the primary Club logo through the early 2000s. This logo is often used by owners of vintage airstreams and members with strong caravan interests.

Wally Byam Airstream Club (WBAC) logo



This logo was based on the Heritage WBCCI logo, but added "Airstream" in the design. It was introduced in the early 2000's and used as the primary Club logo for several years. Members of WBCCI who joined after mid-2000 have been issued this logo on their name badges, club material and trailer decals.
