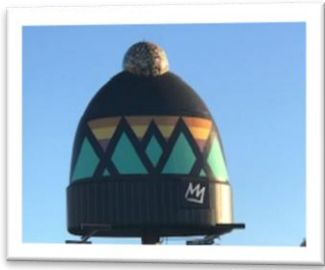

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE RULES & GUIDELINES

Please read the following RV guidelines carefully, as there have been some changes. These rules are necessary for your safety and the safety of others. Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in ejection from the race site, forfeiture of all money paid, and cancellation of future renewals for the event.

PLEASE READ—RV CHECK-IN PROCEDURES— **NO EXCEPTIONS**

1.) Unless arrangements have been made at the Bayfair office prior to September 1, 2019, RV check-in gate hours for Ski Beach, Crown Point and Fiesta Island are as follows (NO EXCEPTIONS):

Thursday, September 12 th	12 p.m. to 9 p.m.
Friday, September 13 th	8 a.m. to 9 p.m.
Saturday, September 14 th	8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

RVs in all areas must vacate the event site no later than 12 p.m., Monday, September 16, 2019 or your vehicle will be impounded and towed at the owners' expense.

2.) No selling of any kind is permitted in RV areas, parking lots, or any other areas that are under control of San Diego Bayfair. This is not only official race policy; it is also a violation of the City of San Diego ordinance.

3.) All vehicles and RVs shall permanently affix parking stickers to the lower left corner of the windshield by removing back to access adhesive, if applicable. No taping allowed. Stickers should be applied prior to arrival to the event site. Failure to display proper parking credentials will result in **immediate towing** of the vehicle from the race site without notice. Towing will be enforced this year. Please follow the rules so everyone has a good time.

4.) Every attendee of the event is required to wear an intact admission wristbands, (on their wrist) at all times while on the race site. Failure to produce a wristband will result in ejection from the race site. Taped or stapled wristbands are **not allowed** and will result in removal from the race site. If you received a wristband broken in your package you must notify the race office upon receipt (prior to the start of the event), we will have a list already prepared of replacements, and these will be the only exchanges we make. You will be required to purchase a wristband if you do not have one intact or will be escorted from the event.

5.) A NOISE CURFEW will be in effect from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. daily beginning Thursday, September 12, 2019. This applies to all types of noise including, but not limited to, music, parties, stereos, and generators.

6.) Please keep all camp gear, chairs, tables, tents, equipment, etc. inside your reserved area. No canopies with top or umbrellas are allowed in the race spectator area to avoid blocking the views of others.

7.) No scaffolding and/or lift equipment of any type are allowed at the race site.

8.) No climbing or removal of fencing shall be permitted.

9.) Due to sponsorship agreements no unofficial advertising is allowed at the event site. Flags, signs and/or banners shall not be any higher than 11 feet from the ground, and are not allowed to obstruct the view of others. All other signage shall be at the discretion of race officials. No stakes are allowed to be used on the turf area anywhere in Mission Bay Park.

10.) Campfires must be built inside approved fire rings only. Please monitor your fire and keep small enough to prevent flying embers from posing a hazard. Fires damaging any grass area will result in a charge to the space owner for repair and payment is required before future RV renewals. See www.sandiegobayfair.org for approved fire pit.

11.) Please direct any complaints or problems to security guards at the entrance and exit gates or to a race official or the race office.

12.) All RVs and/or vehicles must be parked within your designated area. Any vehicles blocking fire lanes or access driveways will be towed immediately without notice. There are No "U"-shaped RV compounds allowed. These rules are by order of the Fire Marshal and will be strictly enforced at all times.

13.) There are no facilities for dumping of gray/black water at the event site. Disposal of gray/black water in the bay or surrounding areas is against the law.

14.) There are no motorized vehicles of any type permitted to be operated within the event site. This includes: golf carts, off-road vehicles, motorcycles, scooters, etc., regardless if it's licensed or not. There are no exceptions to this rule. Only official event vehicles are permitted to operate within the event site. Our security and race staff will strictly enforce this rule as will SDPD. All official vehicles must have a placard.

15.) Bicycles shall be walked inside the event site at all times. No skateboards or scooters are permitted on sidewalks and/or walkways at any time.

16.) **No smoking** anywhere in Mission Bay Park (City Ordinance), you will be fined and a ticket can be given.

17.) **NO dogs** allowed inside the event at any time per City Ordinance and Insurance.

18.) No stakes allowed in grass. We must adhere to all rules set forth in Mission Bay Park, in addition to event rules.

19.) All tow vehicles must be off the grass and parked in asphalt spaces. There is no driving on the grass to drop anyone or anything off after Thursday at 5 p.m. No in and out access for vehicles parked on grass. All cars parked on the asphalt must have a purchased parking pass. Any fines Bayfair receives for vehicles on the grass will be passed on to vehicle owner and payment will be required in order to return to the event.

20.) **You are responsible for your RV site at all times.** This includes the conduct of your family, guests, damage to the trees, bushes, plants and grass in Mission Bay Park and the cleanup of trash and debris. All trash must be disposed of in the trash containers located around the site. You will be charged any additional cost for trash/debris removal left in your space. Payment is required prior to renewal.

21) No drones or controlled flying or hovering devices of any kind allowed.

Remember the San Diego Bayfair is a "family festival," please make certain that you and your guests are considerate towards your neighbors and fellow spectators at all times. Failure to comply could result in loss of space. We need to remember to take care of Mission Bay Park and leave it in better condition than we found it.
