Business Meeting of MN Airstream Club/MN unit of WBCCI

5/28/18

Meeting held via Zoom with 10 members attending.

Meeting called to order by Club President Chuck Dodd at 5:16PM

Introduction of new 2nd VP Kevin Garrett made by President. Kevin was voted in via email by the unanimous consent of the Executive Board after he volunteered for the position following the resignation of 1st VP Terry Pfleghaar. (Per Constitution, Brenda Schultz automatically moves up to 1st VP position.)

Roll call of Executive Board completed as follows by Recording Secretary, Kay Olsson.

Quorum declared by Recording Secretary.

Presentation by President made of the 3 proposed amendments to the International Constitution as presented in the May issue of the Blue Beret and opened to the group for discussion. There were no objections made by the group to passing of the amendments.

A motion was made by Pete Yanke to make President Chuck Dodd delegate for the International Delegates Meeting, amended by Chris Olsson that the club be represented by the President or his choice of substitute, seconded by Dan Johnson. Motion passed unanimously. Chuck announced that Kay Olsson will be the delegate due to his unavailability for the Delegates Meeting on June 24th, 2020. Voting will be completed on-line by delegates by June 15th, and results announced at the Delegates Meeting held via Zoom.

Other business:

Potential new logo for MN Club brought up and discussed. There is a potential new logo that was discussed at the Fall 2019 Business meeting and tabled until President could look further into it. Kay Olsson explained that we have no current "approved" logo meaning it has not gone through the official approval of the International Club. In order to have an official logo, the

logo first needs to be voted in by the MN Club, then sent to Region 7 for approval. If approved, Region 7 would then forward the application to International for approval. It was decided that Chris Olsson, newsletter editor, will place the potential new logo on the next newsletter (in July) to acquaint the members with it. (See the logo on the cover page - ed.)

President Chuck Dodd asked for a brief Treasurer's report given by Craig McHenry:

Checking: \$7316.23

Savings: \$2342.22

Total: \$9658.45

Membership report by Diana McHenry: 98 members and 10 associates currently. Our membership has remained stable for the past several years, those dropping out due to age/sale of their Airstreams offset by new members.

A Motion was made by Treasurer Craig McHenry that Pete Yanke become his backup for treasurer as previous backup is no longer a member. Seconded by Dan Johnson. The motion was passed unanimously.

Meeting adjourned by President Chuck Dodd at 5:43PM.

IBT Summary

As designated delegate for the Minnesota Airstream Club, I attended the IBT Zoom meeting on 6/24/2020. Election of officers for 2020-21 had already been completed by online ballot between June 1 - 15. This was a change from usual procedure due to Covid 19 and cancellation of our 2020 International Rally. It was quite simple to complete and submit. All three amendments to the International Constitution were ratified also per the same process. Results were announced at the IBT.

The report from International headquarters included an announcement of the change in badges of members. There are 3 logos now that can be ordered for new badges: 2 use the classic Wally Byam picture but the wording has been adjusted for current times, and the 3rd has the new Airstream Club logo on it. These can be ordered by logging in to the International Club website and accessing the Club store.

Committee reports included:

Caravans: 17 cancelled this year. 3 are still scheduled for October. All money was returned if the Club cancelled the event.

Also, the Club Caravan handbook is in the process of being updated and will be in digital format when completed.

Bylaws amendments included:

Delegates voting in the future will vote number of members for or against a proposal based on voting within the Club prior to the IBT. Language was adjusted to specify that members must be polled for voting purposes. Members at large will be able to vote by mail or email prior to the IBT if they request from International. (Members at large have not had a vote in the past.)

Language of the Club emblems/logos that local clubs can use was clarified.

Dues for International and subsequent inclusion in the Club Directory was changed from November 30 to December 31.

There were also several amendments to clarify wording of articles without changing the article itself.

The meeting is on the WBCCI.org website and can be read in it's entirety, or watched as video is available.

Hot Shrimp Dip

1 pkg. (8 oz.) cream cheese 1 tsp. 1emon juice

2 T. milk

1/4 tsp. salt 2 green onions, thinly Dash pepper sliced, (tops included)

1 T. chopped pimiento

1 tsp. prepared horseradish

Dash tabasco sauce

1 can (4-1/2 oz.) small

shrimp, drained Assorted crackers or

vegetables

Microwave (full power) cream cheese in glass bowl 1/2 to 1 minute or until softened. Blend in milk until smooth. Stir in remaining ingredients except crackers. Microwave (full power), uncovered, 1-1/2 to 2-1/2 minutes or until hot, stirring once. Serve warm with favorite crackers or raw vegetables.

About 1-3/4 Cups

Croutons

2 cups bread cubes, with crusts removed

1/2 tsp. paprika

1/2 tsp. onion salt or cheese

2 T. butter or margarine, melted

flavor salt

Mix together all ingredients in 2-quart utility dish, stirring to coat bread with other ingredients. microwave (full power) for 3 to 4 minutes or until croutons are dry. Stir once during heating. will become crisper as they cool.

Yield: 1-1/2 Cups

Pizza on a Cracker

36 melba toast rounds or dry 1 can (6-oz.) tomato paste crisp crackers 3 oz. pepperoni, thinly sliced 3/4 cup shredded mozzarella 1 tsp. basil cheese

Place 12 crackers on uncoated paper plate.

Spread 1/2 teaspoon tomato paste on each cracker. Top each with 1 slice pepperoni, 1 teaspoon shredded cheese; sprinkle with basil.

Microwave at High 30 to 60 seconds, or until cheese is melted, rotating plate 1/4 turn after 20 seconds. Repeat with remaining ingredients.

Makes 36

Chicken Bits

4 chicken breasts, boned and 1/2 cup grated Parmesan or skinned
Romano cheese
1-1/2 cups Pepperidge Farm 1/2 tsp. garlic powder Herb Stuffing Mix 1/2 cup, or more, melted 5 T. minced parsley butter

Cut chicken breasts into bite-sized pieces. In medium-sized mixing bowl, combine stuffing mix, parsley, cheese and garlic powder. Mix well. Roll chicken pieces in melted butter. Press into stuffing mixture until all sides are coated well. Place on lightly greased baking sheet. Bake at 350° for 10 minutes, or until lightly browned.

Newsletter Editor Ramblings

Last month, I started a series of articles about Little Girl and our refurbishment of her. For those of you that don't know, Little Girl is our 1972 31 ft Sovereign that we completely gutted and rebuilt over the course of several years.

But I'm going to take a break from her refurb and report on her dent.

Last Fall, while pulling her out of her shelter on our way to the Fall rally, it was pouring rain, and I clipped the end post of the shelter and put a nice dent in the aft starboard panel.

Well, the weather finally got warm, and the sun was shining on her (to warm up the aluminum skin), so we decided it was time to try out my new tool and see if we could get the dent out.



So, we removed the trim pieces (lots of rivets to drill out). I got out my new pneumatic dent puller, fired up the air compressor, hooked the dent puller up to the air compressor, put it on the dent, drew a vacuum with the air compressor which suctioned to the trailer quite well, and tried a small sample pull to see how hard it was going to be to remove the dent.

This is the result of the small sample pull.

The dent popped out with hardly any pulling at all! It was in fact, very anti-climactic. But, very pleasing.

Below are two more pics with the trim put back on. There is still a shadow of a crease from the dent, but we are quite happy with how well it turned out.
