Caravan Leaders Needed for a New England Caravans

Trevor and Gail Lake will be leading their last Nor by Nor'East caravan this summer, so we are looking for new caravan leaders. I would like to have the caravan split into two parts, one in the New England area and the other in the Canadian Maritime provinces. There are plenty of attractions and activities to have two 20-30 day caravans in each region. They do not need to run concurrently, in fact it might be better if they did not because many folks might try to combine the two. The following is the description of the caravan as presented on the WBAC website.

The Nor by Nor'east National Caravan will begin in southern New England and end in Price Edward Island, Canada. We begin the caravan in RI and visit nearby Mystic Seaport, CT and Newport, Rl. We continue on to Plymouth, MA which is steeped in history; visiting "Plimoth" Plantation, Plymouth Rock, Mayflower II and much much more. Boston's stop is a very busy one with 2 days of tour bus rides from the Topsfield Fairgrounds into Boston. A// those sites you've read about in history books will be part of our journey. JFK Library, Bunker Hill Monument, Old Ironsides a chance to eat lunch in the North End and a tour ride on a trollev to see the rest of the historic sites around Boston. Continuing up the coastline to an Oceanside campsite in Searsport, ME and then nearby Bar Harbor will make you a firm

believer that Maine is beautiful. A will enjoy the Penobscot Marine Museum, Fort Knox and the Penobscot Narrows Observatory. We will enjoy a real Down East Style Lobster Bake at the campground. Continuing on to FDR's retreat at Campobello island in New Brunswick, Canada and enjoy "Tea with Eleanor". Then on to Moncton where we will visit Hopewell Cape to see the exaggerated tides of the Bay of Fundy. Nova Scotia's 3 stops include campsites that will be home bases so we can travel to Peggy's Cove, Halifax. Louisbourg, Beddeck and of course the Cabot Trail. This caravan includes many lobster dinners and free days to explore on vour own. A trip across to Price Edward Island on a ferry and you will think you are in Heaven. Enjoy the entertainment and restaurants in Charlottetown, local seafood PEI style and a great ice cream shop nearby the campground. We will have our Farwell Banquet in Charlottetown.

Currently there are three caravans located entirely in Canada and led by Canadians (Viking-Leggatt, Canadian Rockies-Nentwig and Collinson, Northern Lights and Polar Bears-Harrower) and I would like to locate some more Canadian leaders for the Canadian Maritimes caravan. The two caravans already run, Viking and Canadian Rockies, have been very popular and successful as will be the Polar Bear. Keeping the caravans in one country makes the currency "tracking" much simpler.

It would be great to have someone from the New England region develop and lead a "New England" caravan. Again, there are many locations and activities in the New England region to develop an excellent caravan.

Do you know of anyone who might be interested in leading the modified Nor by Nor'east caravan. I believe strongly that co-leaders, i.e. two, three or four people make a better combination of leaders if they can be found. We will make every effort to provide training for those folks. Also Trevor might be able to include them on the 2020 caravan.






