On Sunday May 3<sup>rd</sup>, I called an Executive Board meeting to discuss alternative venues that we can use in lieu of our rallies and upcoming spring business meeting. Among some of the things that were discussed were video conferencing, official online voting, and email service. How we wanted to proceed with these as a temporary measure until we can have our spring business meeting where our members can officially vote these into policy. We also moved our spring business meeting to Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 7pm so that everyone has time to get the agenda and participate in a few virtual happy hours to become comfortable with them and get any questions answered that anyone may have.

The board voted to use the video service Zoom since it's the most common one used. I set up a business account with them, since it's the most secure venue out there with passwords and data encryption. We used the free version for the meeting with some difficulty, and would like to go to the basic paid version so that our business meetings and virtual happy hours will go smoothly. The cost is \$149 a year, well worth it in our opinion. You will be voting on this at the business meeting.

The club has used SurveyMonkey in the past and it has worked well as an option to in person voting. We will create a club account and continue this service.

Finally, I suggested that we create a new volunteer position within our club, a technical coordinator. Someone who is familiar with all of these new venues and can manage them for the club. There will be more about this in this newsletter.

I am going to schedule our first club virtual happy hour on Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 5pm. (I have already hosted a Pets and Paws virtual happy hour which was a huge success.) An email will be going out to everyone in the club with instructions on how to attend a Zoom video chat. Please refer to the Zoom instructions in this newsletter. On March 31, 2020, the International Board of Trustees voted unanimously to adopt an Emergency Resolution declaring a proclamation of emergency due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). - Continue giving the free rally coupon to new members joining the unit for CCMAC sponsored rallies. (We pay for the 2 nights parking only; the recipient is responsible for the kitty fee.) This excludes National Event Rallies.

## What is a Zoom and how do I join a meeting?

### What is a Zoom meeting?

Zoom is a video conferencing where groups of 2-100 can come together.

### How does a Zoom meeting work?

Zoom allows you to video conference with others on your laptop, computer, tablet or mobile phone. You can participate by auto with or with out using the video features.

### How to I set up Zoom on my device?

The first step is to download and install Zoom. To ensure a pleasant experience with your first Zoom Meeting, we highly encourage individuals to download and install the Zoom Application beforehand.

**On a computer or laptop** - To download and install the Zoom Application:

1. Go to <https://zoom.us/download> and from the Download Center, click on the Download button under "Zoom Client For Meetings".
2. Once the download is complete, proceed with installing the Zoom application onto your computer.



**iPhone / iPad** - Zoom Cloud Meetings app (available on the [App Store](#)).

1. Open the the App Store on your Apple device
2. Search for ZOOM Cloud Meetings
3. Locate and tap the entry by zoom.us
4. Tap Install
5. Read the permissions listing
6. If the permissions listing is acceptable, tap Accept
7. Allow the installation to complete
