

2020 camping season gets off to a late start July's "River Rally" is NORVA's first outing as the pandemic eases in Northern Virginia

Tn the heat of July, light first appeared Lat the end of the COVID-19 tunnel as Virginia began "Phase 3" of what was hoped would be a slow return to a "new normal." The "River Rally," hosted by Doug and Susan Anderson, became NORVA's first camping rally of the 2020 season, July 17-19. Normally, NORVA's camping season begins in March, with rallies held throughout the spring, summer, and fall. Not this year. The menacing coronavirus pandemic caused the cancellation or postponement of every Club activity from March through June; including the International Rally in Colorado, the Region 3 Rally in Myrtle Beach, S.C.,





the Maintenance Rally (postponed to Aug. 28-30) and the NORVA "Ohio Presidents" Club Caravan (now rescheduled for Sept. 24-Oct. 9).

This was the Andersons first time as volunteer rally hosts. "We started planning this back in January," said Doug. "We were able to reserve ten sites at this beautiful park and, almost immediately, members signed up to occupy all of them! Aside from the stifling July heat this weekend, *which was not in the plan*, it turned out to be a great rally."

Tom Carmichael, NORVA's president, was delighted that a majority of the attendees were some of the Club's newest members. He told the group he hoped the worst of times is now in the rear-view mirror and expressed optimism that the remaining events on NORVA's 2020 schedule will go as planned. "I'm looking forward to a large turnout from all four Virginia Airstream clubs the last weekend of August when I will be hosting our rescheduled Maintenance Rally in Powhatan," Tom said. NORVA's annual Maintenance Rally, usually conducted in late March or early April, was postponed this year because of the virus pandemic. On July 1, with cases of the virus rapidly declining in Virginia, the governor directed the state to enter "Phase 3" of its "reopening" plan.

As restrictions on group gatherings continued to ease, NORVA's president, Tom Carmichael, worked closely with 1st VP Gerry Nagel and they rescheduled the Maintenance Rally for Aug. 28-30 at Cozy Acres Family Campground, Powhatan, Va. The campground set aside 50 well-spaced sites to accommodate the Airstream group. As of July 20th, 30 Virginia Airstreamers had reserved sites; 20 sites were still available.

DJ Mastin, independent Airstream technician and owner of Broken Rivets RV Service, LLC, will be on hand the whole weekend to discuss all aspects of maintaining Airstream trailers and Class C vans. Attendees will learn how to keep their RV systems and appliances in good shape. Also, DJ will be available to perform minor work on trailers during the rally weekend at a discounted rate.

NORVA officer elections will occur in August

Business meeting to be held during the August Maintenance Rally to accept a candidate slate

Once again we approach that time of year when officers and directors for the Club's leadership positions are nominated, elected, and inducted. A call for members to fill these volunteer positions appeared in the June issue of *NORVA News*. Based on the response, the Club's Executive Board recently approved a proposed slate of candidates prepared by the nominating committee.

The membership will be asked to vote on this slate by e-mail ballot in early August. According to Past President Dick Arnold, who chaired the Nominating Committee, it is still possible to volunteer for one of these leadership positions. Arnold said he will accept additional nominations by e-mail (janea40@gmail.com) and will ask the Executive Board to add them to the ballot if he receives them before Aug. 1.

The duties of Club officers and directors are described in Article V of the NORVA "Bylaws," and may be read on Pages 43 to 45 of the 2020 NORVA Directory. They can also be viewed on-line at: <u>https://NorthernVirginia.</u> <u>airstreamclub.net</u>. On the home page, click on "NORVA Constitution and Bylaws." Note: Qualified candidates for any Club leadership position must be a "life" or "regular" NORVA member for at least six months. They cannot be members of another Airstream club who also joined NORVA as "affiliate" members.

In early August, a ballot showing a final slate will be e-mailed to all NORVA members eligible to vote. Each NORVA Airstream Club duespaying "household" has one vote in the election. ("Affiliate" members do *not* vote.) Members will vote by responding to the e-mail, indicating either a "yes" or "no" vote on the slate. Although voting in favor of the slate is recommended by the Executive Board, there will also be space on the e-mail ballot to write-in the name(s) of other Club members qualified and agreeable to accept a leadership position. If a member household does not vote by the cutoff date specified in the e-mail, it will be counted as a "yes" vote for the slate.

Election results will be announced by NORVA President Tom Carmichael shortly after the vote is counted, and the new leaders will be inducted at the NORVA business meeting to be held on Friday, Aug. 28, during the Maintenance Rally in Powhatan (see article on Page 3). The newly elected leaders will serve one-year terms that officially begin on Oct. 1, 2020.

The slate of candidates approved by the Executive Board in July appears in the sidebar at right. Each candidate listed has agreed to serve, if elected.

NORVA's Ohio Presidents and Historic Icons Caravan remains on schedule for Sept. 24 through Oct. 9 and currently has eight openings remaining to be filled for a maximum of 15 participating Airstreams.

If you enjoy vibrant presidential history written in America's most prolific growth years captured in the late 19th and early 20th Centuries, come join us for a tour of Ohio and the eight men it claims as its own (W.H. Harrison, Grant, Hayes, Garfield, B. Harrison, McKinley, Taft, and Harding). Add planned (and/or elective) visits to the numerous icons of the Buckeye state including prominent underground railroad homes, the Wright brother's cycle and aviation museums, the new Airstream Factory, the National First Ladies Historical Site, the NFL Hall of Fame, the National Museum of the United States Air Force, America's only metal whistle factory, the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, and many more unique venues to suit even the most eclectic of tastes, and you have a journey designed to experience the joys of both American history and American culture. Each participant can anticipate being kept fully on-board in real time via email with respect to these communications and will receive a full refund of any monies expended should the caravan be postponed.

Whether this event is accomplished in Sept/Oct 2020 or May/June 2021, we commit to each participant our continuing best efforts to ensure a rewarding, robust, and enjoyable experience.
