The Importance of Emergency Planning

The best way to handle an emergency is to be prepared for one. Knowing what to do ahead of time can help you stay in control so that you can help.

Most of the time we travel to new destinations out of State and sometimes to remote locations having no idea of the availability and response time for emergency assistance. Having an <u>Emergency Plan</u> included in your travel itinerary is simple and should be a part of your trip preparation whether you travel by yourself or with a group.

Generally, a travel plan would include, miles driven per day, re-fueling stops, tools & equipment, overnight reservations, food stops, and site-seeing. However, we don't include information on what to have or do in the event of emergency.

Following are areas of consideration during your trip planning stage:

- 1. Basic electronics (Communications)
- 2. First add kit & fire extinguisher
- 3. Personal needs
- 4. Clothing
- 5. Your medications and Rx
- 6. Necessary documentation
- 7. Cash


Things to consider when reporting an emergency:

- 1. Take a deep breath and stay calm
- Call 911
- 3. Say your name and location of emergency, including address, site and trailer number
- 4. Explain what the emergency is and how many people are hurt
- 5. Follow all operator's instructions carefully
- 6. Stay on the phone until operator says it's OK to hang up
- 7. When First Responders arrive do not interfere, they have operational control of the emergency

Things to include in your emergency form:

- A. Campground information: Name, Address, Phone Numbers, and Rally Dates.
- B. Rally Primary and Secondary Contact: Name and Cell Phone Numbers.
- 1. Hospitals
- 2. Fire Department & Emergency Medical Services
- 3. Dental Care
- 4. Eye Care
- 5. Pharmacy
- 6. Animal Hospital


