This would be the best time to pay the cashier. ONE PERSON WILL COLLECT EVERYTHING AT CAMPGROUND AND PAY THE CASHIER. We accept MC, Visa, Discover, or a check from your organization.

Below I have attached the registration/waiver form so people could fill them out in advance.

We need one form per family but each guest must sign the waiver at the bottom. This form is for your safety and our liability. We must know who is out on the Farm. The group will gather in the auditorium for a brief introductory video. If warranted, we will divide you into 2 or 3 sub-groups so all get a good Tour. A golf cart can be reserved for any who should not walk the whole Tour. Also, I can hold the screened pavilion for you to picnic (food not provided) after the Tour.

All visitors: should have a refillable water bottle, should wear sunglasses &/ a visor or hat should wear comfortable, closed walking shoes may want to use sunscreen Please, use the insect repellent that we make available.

Visitors may have phones for photos but please, NO TEXTS NOR CALLS during the tour.

Please, respect the Docents, trained volunteers who will give you a great tour. Visitors will stay with the group. Stragglers and wanderers distract from the tour. Visitors must not touch, pet, nor attempt to feed ANY of the farm animals. Visitors must not pick/eat anything on the Farm unless invited. Some plants are in fact harmful.

Visitors must stay on the tour path. We share the Farm with creepy, crawly things best left alone.
