It is said that to experience the "Real" Florida you need to visit a Florida State Park. And, we did just that by camping 3 nights each in 3 different parks in late February and early March. We had:

16 rigs at Highlands Hammock 2/24-26

15 rigs at Blue Springs 2/27-3/1

9 rigs at Hillsborough River 3/2-4

Highlands Hammock offered us a great fire ring to meet around, a history of CCC in a museum setting and a great tram tour explaining the animals and plants in the hammock and old growth cypress swamp. Many in our group experienced racing at Sebring Raceway, the murals in Lake Placid and the 1000 year old oak tree.

Blue Springs, on the St. John's River, is a manatee refuge, but few were there when we visited. Never the less we had a super river boat tour at De Leon Springs State Park, along with a cook your own pancake breakfast. We were able to visit Susan's hometown of Deland and marvel at her quilted crafts which were displayed in her home!

Hillsborough River was a great opportunity to hike some trails and enjoy the natural beauty of one of Florida's 1st state parks. Not far from there was Ybor City and the Strawberry Festival.

Beth mentioned that we are looking into doing the Sarasota Rally January 29, 2020 for the Elvis Presley Impersonation weekend.


Announcements:

An easy way to store the hitch while camping.







These are the air vents from my trailer. I clean them every 3 month to ensure the heating and air conditioning units work properly.

This is specifically important for Airstreams with ducted roof units.





Brisket by Myra

First Cut Brisket 4-4.5 lb 2 Onions 4-5 Garlic Cloves Chopped Kosher Concord Grape Wine



Leave fat on Bottom of Brisket and sear the top and the bottom. Season with salt & pepper. Set oven or electric fry pan for 200-225' and leave for 1 and 1/2 hours. The more wine you add the better. Slice against the grain to serve.
