BULGER (Wheat Pilaf) ~ Russ Melocik Olive Oil Orzo 1 Cup Bulger Wheat 1 Can Campbell Chick Broth Water Pepper

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Have all ingredients handy and ready to combine. Over hot burner in a 1-2 Qt pot, add Orzo to cover the bottom. Cover the Orzo with olive oil. Heat at highest burner setting until the instant the Orzo starts to turn tan. Immediately add Bulger Wheat, chicken broth and 2/3 broth-can water in that order. Sprinkle with ground black pepper. As soon as the mix boils, stir from the bottom and lower heat to the lowest setting that will maintain simmer. Serve moist. Cooks like rice. Hint: Do not overcook. Do not substitute for Campbell Chicken Broth. Do not substitute for OliveOil. Bulger is pronounced "Bull'whore."




