Letter sent to the community of Havana...

Below is a copy of the information that was sent to the people in Havana who were involved in setting up the Havana Rally. Scott sent this letter several weeks ago, and to date, he hasn't had any response. This will most likely be discussed again at an upcoming rally.

The Big Bend Airstream Club of Florida has had numerous inquiries about the status of the 2021 Havana Main Street Rally. After careful consideration, we have decided to postpone the Havana Main Street Rally until 2022.

The primary factor in our decision was the availability of a vaccine for the virus and secondarily its early adoption rate. Considering the highly contagious nature of COVID 19 and the fact that our event draws participants from all over the country. We felt it would be socially irresponsible to attract a large audience to our Rally, which by its very nature encourages fellowship and close socialization, only to send them out across the country to possibly spread the virus unknowingly to friends or family. We all agreed the potential risk was too high to move forward with the planning of the 2021 Havana Main Street Rally.

We also considered the ramifications of scheduling an event, only to cancel at the last minute and the negative effect that might have for future events in the wonderful City of Havana FL.

We hope you will stick with us and make 2022 a Rally that will once again be the talk of not only Havana but the Airstream community as well.








2020 Christmas Dinner Information



Club History... from Carol Montague: Formation and Naming of the Club

In 1974, Mac and Marty McCauslin joined the South Georgia unit since WBCCI had no club in the geographical area of Tallahassee. They soon realized that a unit which held only 2 week-long rallies a year did not fit a working person's lifestyle. Along with others from the vicinity, they contacted WBCCI on June 28,1974 asking what they needed to do to form a new club. An organizational meeting was held September 11, 1974 with 25 families represented. At that time, they selected the name Big Bend Florida Unit. This name was chosen since 'big bend' was a recreational area identified by the Florida Department of Commerce and was used in numerous publications including the official state map. According to Mac, WBCCI headquarters replied that the name was not acceptable since Texas was well known for its Big Bend area. A Florida map was sent to International indicating our region as Big Bend. So, we became the Big Bend Florida Unit, even though we have often been introduced as Big Bend Texas at International Rallies.

For many years, our rallies were held the first weekend in the month and were held within 100 miles of Tallahassee. As our unit representation extended to a wider area of Florida and Georgia, this began to change. Now there are no limitations on where a rally will be held. Through the years there have been either 8 or 9 rallies a year (no rally in June, July or August and sometimes not in December or January.) The incoming President and/or his committee have selected the dates and locations. These rallies normally cover Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, although often people arrive on Thursday or stay until Monday. Rallies have been held at private and State campgrounds and at a few other facilities. If you find a special camping place that you think would be a good rally site, be sure to let the incoming President know.

Our unit, (now club, after a name change to Big Bend Florida Club in recent years), has prided itself in never having to ask a past president to repeat as president. Our first president was Mac McCauslin. In 1984 we elected our first female President - Ruby Lewis. We have had a number of couples who have been President in different years – Blow, Montague, Skipper, Thompson, and Duncan. Our club has ranged in number of members (rigs) from 45-65 throughout the years. The club has usually had a good representation at the Florida State Rally (no longer held), the Region 3 Rally, and the International Rally. We have had two Region 3 Presidents – Mac McCauslin and Jay Thompson. We have also had a number of caravan leaders from the club – Strong, Thompson, Montague, Skipper and Anderson. We look forward to seeing all of you – old and new faces – at a rally.



Why I Use Viair 300p-rvs

What works for me:

As we socialize at our rallies, a subject will always come up on how to or, what to use in a certain situation. I've decided to put my thoughts in our newsletter. If you have a certain way of doing some thing or a piece of equipment that would benefit our members, please share.

At the last few gatherings, air compressors have come up. We have all been there, on the road or at the campsite in need of compressed air. Last February I found myself needing air for my tires. To my aid, Lamar Waymire lent me his brand spanking new, still in the plastic wrapper Viair 300p-rvs air compressor. This compressor was amazing and made short work of bringing all four of my truck tires back to the proper pressure. So if you're looking for what I consider the "Cat's Meow" of portable air compressors, look for the Viair 300p-rvs. It works for me.



And on that note, "See You Down the Road!" (Or at the Dump Station... we have GOT to stop meeting like this!)
