

Thus began the steps to sell the Wheeler's 2007 27' Airstream. Bob and I first reached out to Linda Maddox of LTAC and asked if she could get some shots of the interior and exterior of the Airstream. Linda efficiently handled this task. Next, I made a call to Jim Polk, a member of the Greater Los Angeles Airstream Club and senior member of the American Society of Appraisers. Within days Jim provided a fair market price for the Airstream. Within two days of listing the Airstream for sale, a call was received from a couple who reside in Casper, Wyoming. They said they were very interested in the Airstream at the listed price and would arrive in Carson City, Nevada the following afternoon.
