President's Message COVID-19 Update Bad News/Good News

I am writing this message on November 23rd and the status of this subject changes daily, but those following this topic realize that close-in holiday contact could bring an increased risk of virus exposure. HOWEVER, there are now immunizations which could be ready for distribution as early as mid-December 2020.



The Bad. More than 12 million people in the U.S. have contracted the coronavirus since the start of the pandemic. On November 22nd alone, the Kansas City Metropolitan area added 1,200 new cases. Health care representatives advise that people reduce exposure, stay inside and so on. This of course is difficult during the holidays where we typically have guests and the weather encourages most to stay indoors.

The Good. This difficult recent news is tempered with the recent announcements by Pfizer, Moderna Inc. and AstraZeneca that they have developed vaccines which are more than 90% effective. The first shots could be available within weeks. *This is extremely good news.*



Planning for the International Rally! - John Eckardt

Knowledge of the recently developed vaccines makes me hopeful that our scheduled 2021 late April Spring Rally can occur. Time will tell but I'm planning as if it will. In addition, the International Club continues planning for the July 17-24, 2021 **International Rally in Lebanon, TN**. Maria and I have already registered.

We have decided to leave about one week early and do some "tune-up" camping in portions of Kentucky and Tennessee. Maria has never been there and there is a lot to see and do. Knowing that up to 800 Airstreams could arrive at Lebanon during the rally, and anticipating that others will want to do the something similar—camp in the region prior to the rally--we have now made camping reservations in three

different locations. Our first stop will be three nights at "**My Old Kentucky Home State Park**" in Bardstown, KY on July 8--10. Bardstown is located about 45 minutes southeast of Louisville, KY. Some may recognize this location as the base location of the "Kentucky Bourbon and Beyond Caravan 2019" National Rally. Bardstown is often referred to as the Bourbon capital of the World. Likely because there at least five major distillers in and around the town of about 2,500 people. You may have heard of Willett, Barton 1792 and nearby Jim Beam Distilleries. We hope to tour a few distilleries and visit Louisville, Lexington and Mammoth Cave National Park. All of these sites are within a one hour's drive from Bardstown.

In the park, the *historic three-story structure* for which the State Park was named, was completed by the Rowan family in 1818 and made popular due to its connection to Stephen Foster's song "My Old Kentucky Home, Good-Night!" The park offers numerous tours. The "Mint Julep Tour" piqued my interest. We also hope to tour the Louisville Slugger Baseball Bat plant.



From Bardstown, we travel to the Smoky Mountains and stay three nights at the **Greenbrier Campground** a few miles east of Gatlinburg, TN. I've requested travel information from all stops and will be working on each stop's itinerary in the next few months. While in Gatlinburg, seeing the town, driving the 11-mile Cades Cove loop and hiking local park trails will be the core of filling the three days there. From Gatlinburg we travel about 150 miles southwest to **Harrison Bay State Park** located just northeast of Chattanooga, TN.

Topping the "must dos" in Chattanooga are seeing the *Choo Choo*, Rock City and Ruby Falls. With a little luck, the *Andrew Sisters* will be singing "The Chattanooga Choo Choo" to the Glenn Miller Band over the speaker system during our visit.

A representative of the Wally Byam International Rally, told me that those attending the **Lebanon, TN** event will get a "parking call" from the Club a few months prior to event start. She said that although the Rally starts on July 17th, parking for the event will likely begin on the 14th.

If anyone is interested in leaving early for the International Rally and seeing any of these sites, please contact me for information.
