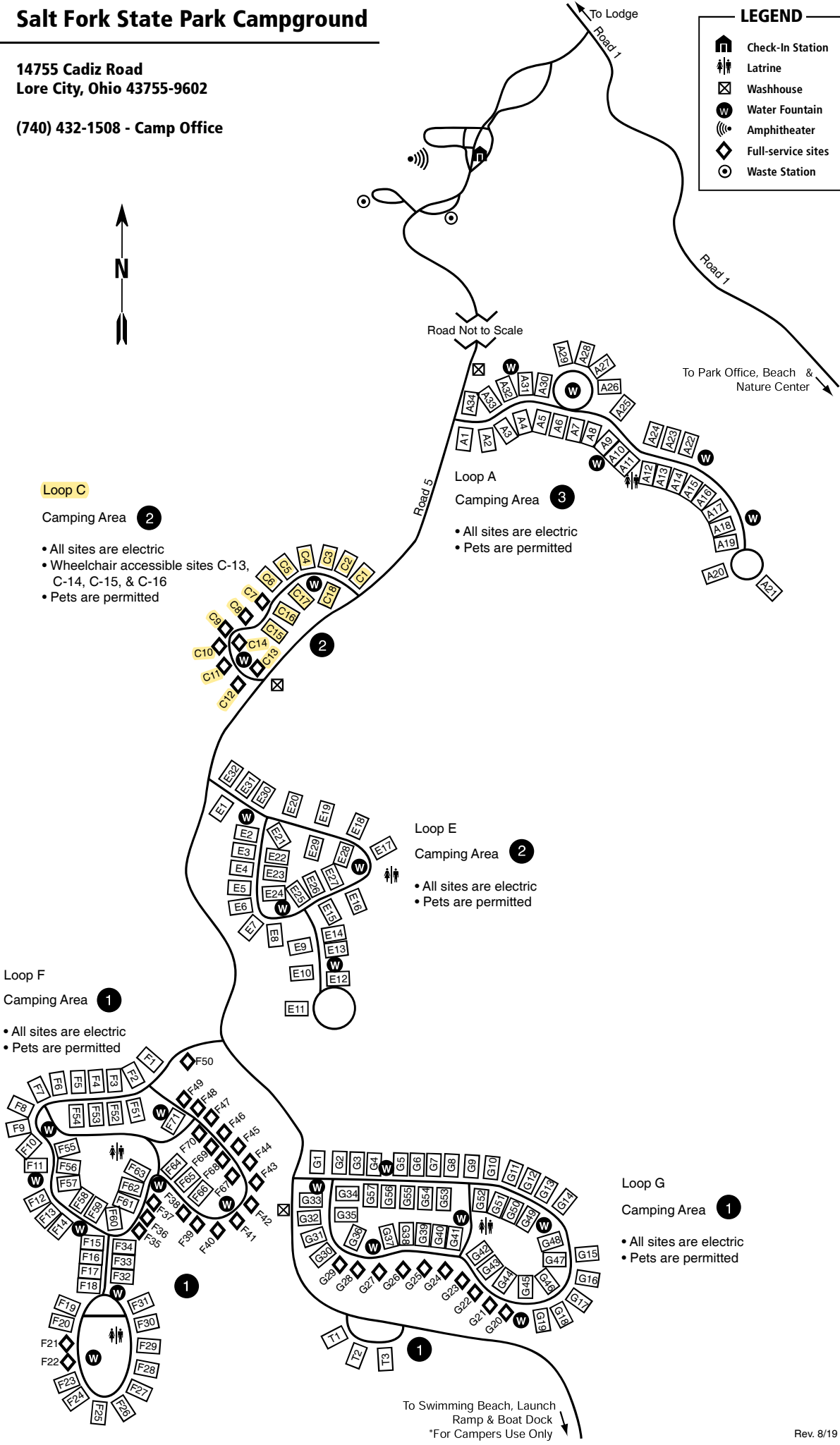

**Thank you for your interest in Salt Fork State Park's Campground.
Our Campground offers the following:**

- 215 Campsites - with electric hook-up, fire rings and picnic tables.
- A limited number of full hook-up sites are also available.
- 3 heated showerhouses with coin operated washers and dryers.
- 5 comfort stations scattered throughout the camp areas.
- 2 dump stations with fresh water available.
- A private beach and boat launching/docking for **registered campers only**.
- A large camp store stocked with your basic necessities, souvenirs and snacks.

REGISTRATION, RENEWALS & CHECK-OUT

- Check-out time is 1:00 PM.
- Camping is limited to no more than 14 days within any 30-day period.
- No person may sublease, transfer or assign their campsite to another person.
- A campsite may not be occupied by more than six (6) people.
- Quiet hours are in effect from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.

EQUIPMENT

- Camping equipment is limited to:
 - A. A tent or tents having a combined maximum floor space not exceeding 200 square feet.
 - B. One camping unit (motor home, travel trailer, etc.) in combination with a tent or tents.
- No more than **TWO (2) motor vehicles** may be parked on the pad at your site. **Neither vehicle may be parked at the shower houses for extended periods of time.**
- Parking on the grass is prohibited. Boats and trailers may be parked on the grass at your campsite.
- Camping equipment may only occupy a site for a maximum of 14 days.

VISITORS

- Camp visiting hours are from **6:00 AM to 10:30 PM**. Visitors may not park at the showerhouses.
- Camp area facilities may not be used by anyone not holding a valid camping permit or other authorization.

PETS

- Pet camping is allowed in all areas.
- Pets must remain on a leash and be walked along the roads and trails, but are not permitted in any buildings or on any beach or playground area.
- It is your responsibility to clean up after your pet and to keep it quiet during quiet hours.
- Please do not leave pets unattended for long periods of time with out proper shade and water.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Alcohol is permitted at your rented campsite only. All other Ohio Revised Code intoxicating beverage rules apply.
- The cutting or collection of firewood is prohibited, as is the cutting of live or dead trees.
- Please do not attach clotheslines to trees or signs.
- **Use of firearms or fireworks is prohibited in camp areas.**
- **Please do not move fire rings from the location you find them.**
- **If you move a picnic table from a site you have registered, you must return it to the original site upon your departure from the campground.**

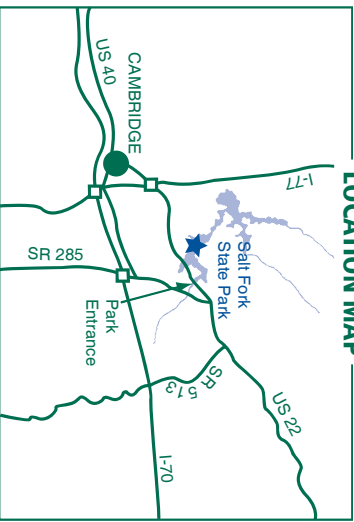
