Happy 2021 Streamers!

Hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas and New Year. It was Soo great to get that year behind us, and we have an exciting schedule of camping ahead for 2021. A Year in Review

• 2020 was Carolinas Airstream Club's 60th Anniversary! With 2020 COVID-19 conditions, it was difficult to celebrate together – but still marks an important milestone in the club's history.

We were at our kick-off rally down at James Island Co. Park in March when news was spreading about lock-downs and restricted group gatherings. As we were leaving, they were closing the park & campground.
April's rally at Tanglewood Park was cancelled. Park Closed. Rally rescheduled for 2021.

• May's urban rally at "Shining in Shelby" was cancelled & moved to 2021.

• June's rally at Pipestem, WV closed & cancelled.

• WBCCI cancelled all Caravans and the International Rally at Loveland, CO.

• In July, we had our rally at Davey Crockett Birthplace SP combined with the East Tennessee AC. Very

subdued - masked & safe & distanced, but perfect weather and everyone had a great time.

• Price of gas dropped below the \$2.00-mark in some locations.

• August rally in Boone, NC, again observing Safe protocols. Lots of rain.

• September rally at Sanctuary Vineyards on the Outer Banks, with much rain & safe protocols, but still a great time had by all.

• October's Carolina Balloon Fest in Statesville was cancelled. Alumalina in Marion had a good showing of rigs – with everyone observing safety protocols.

• November down at Ocean Lakes Family Campground we had 54 rigs! No meals, but stayed safe, and still had a great rally.

And with all this, we had the highest count of new members joining the club in many years. Dealers have sold out of Airstreams & other brands. RV sales hit a record high.

Renewals & New Members

It looks like we have a very high percentage of Renewals this year, and a big crop of new members. Our club is growing. So keep doing what you've been doing and welcome those new members. 
Fascinating. Maybe an unusual hobby. An Evening spread out around a campfire is always a welcome way to wind down the day.



CHARLESTON RALLY PLANS

Because of COVID-19, we wanted to publish some encouragement to attend this first rally of 2021. Clearly COVID-19 is not behind us yet, but we have had several outings, conducted safely, and have reserved tougher decisions to the individuals attending.


In contrast with our usual rallies, we will have no group meals requiring people to sit next to each other around tables. We will have no organized meals at restaurants. Instead, we will have outdoor cocktail hours each afternoon of the rally and attendees will be asked to bring only food that provides individual servings, no communal spoons, knives, etc. Toothpicks may be popular. People will be encouraged to wear masks when not eating or drinking, if they are gathered in groups. On Saturday morning we will attempt to bring in pastries, and prepare a pot of coffee, which will be on a table in the activity room with both doors open. Clearly rain may dampen all of the above plans, but there may be adequate room under the eaves of the activity building and the laundry building.

As we did at the end of 2020 attendees will be on their own for any travel to restaurants (that may be open) or sightseeing.



SOME GOOD THINGS TO KNOW

Welcome to **Silver in the City**, a "*Wake Up Downtown*" Airstream Rally, hosted by members of the Palmetto State Airstream Club 22. We are very glad to have you joining us for this "Third Annual" special and unique event. We will be parking on both sides of main street (Congress Street) in downtown York, SC, population 8500.

This will be a *boondocking* rally so please arrive with a full tank of fresh water and empty grey and black tanks. Quiet generators are welcome. We will have a dump site for departure on Sunday morning. Our Bull Pen will be at 105 Garner Street. The City of York Police Department will assist us in parking. All parking is parallel to the curb, with door to the side walk. Parking begins at 9:00am Friday morning. We will need an accurate rig count, so please let us know if you are coming.

Our plan is to have everyone pull in parallel to the curb and back up. We will help you get parked. You will want to park as close to the curb as possible without scrubbing your tires. All parking is downtown, within easy walking of everything. We also have a large parking lot available for those who do not want to park on the street.

The City Market will serve as our central gathering point where we can assemble as a group for any information sharing. We have a kick off social planned at the City Market around 5:00pm Friday, but other than that, no organized meals or events are planned other than the **OPEN HOUSE** on Saturday afternoon and doughnuts and coffee on Sunday morning. We urge you to patronize the local merchants and restaurants; they are very excited that we are coming and have many specials to offer. Please be sure to wear your Club badge so they can recognize you. We will provide a rally packet with information on what to see and do in York.

We hope you will participate in an **OPEN HOUSE** Saturday afternoon from 1:00pm - 4:00pm, the community will want to peek inside the Airstreams. The street will be closed from 12:00pm - 5:00pm to facilitate foot traffic.

Once again, the rally fee will be a donation to PATH, "People Attempting To Help". PATH is a local, multi Church supported charity that reaches far into the York community. We are suggesting a \$10 or more donation, per person. Checks can be made out to "PATH". Airstreamers make a difference. Please be generous, this is a very worthy organization.

This year our Thursday night pre-rally gathering/celebration will be held at York Place, 234 Kings Mountain Street, York. We will not have any utilities there but we will have plenty of parking on pavement, and only a few blocks from downtown. The entrance will be marked. Please join us there if you can, we will have a supper. From there we will parade into town with police escort on Friday morning. <u>Fly your flags</u>!!
