Member Profile Beacon Editor Glenn Michael



s editor I usually profile other members, but President Katharine suggested I do a profile on myself. Most of the long time members know who I am, but may not know too much about me, and of course the newer members hardly know me at all.

As a youth I camped a lot in the Boy Scouts. I started camping again with my son for a vacation to Disney World, but that was in a tent. That didn't lead to an RV.

As a single parent who was involved in a lot of community organizations, and with a son who also was involved in all kinds of sports, I got to thinking that we weren't home very much. So I thought I would get rid of the house and get an RV and just spend each night wherever the last meeting, or game was held. Of course I didn't go that far, but my first RV was an Itasca Phasar motorhome, made by Winebago and was billed as "the living room you could parallel park." I did park it that way a few times. Numerous times I would go to school in the RV, and then we would take it to the field where my son was playing or having practice. Then I fixed dinner in the RV right at the sport venue. When we finished I would go to my meeting, and he would do homework or watch the TV and then we went home. I also used it for a campaign van to attract attention when I ran for County Commissioner. I told Seth if I won he would have to come to where it was parked at the Court House

Parking lot after school on the days I had meetings. If I lost, and I did by only 300 votes, we would take trips. We went to Florida at Christmas break, Myrtle Beach during spring break, and over the summer we did a wide loop of all the north east states on the east coast from home and back. That was PA, NY, VT, ME, RI, CT, NJ, DE. The big circle was from Maryland to Maine and back across the Cape May Lewes Ferry through Delaware to home.

By the time he got to driving age he was too tall to be comfortable in the Phasar and I traded it on a Class C. After 76,000 miles in the Shasta and a four-way bypass, I was ready to call an end to the RV lifestyle. Alas, I found a deal on an '88 Airstream Excella and FINALLY got to the dream of being an *Airstream* owner. I always liked them and wanted one, but it wasn't in the budget along with a tow vehicle.

I haven't been as many places in the Excella as the Class-C, but in the total time of the three RVs I have stayed in all but seven or so states, and covered over 100,000 miles of driving and great experiences. This is truly a wonderful country we live in and needs to be seen to be truly appreciated.

I taught art 42 years, including one year at St. Michaels Parochial, thirty years at Kent County Public, and eleven years at Gunston School. After a heart attack in 1999, I retired from public school and subbed for a year trying to decide what I would do when I grew up. Then an opportunity opened to teach photography at Gunston, one class, two days a week, eight kids. That morphed into three classes, four days and eventually I was back to work full time at Gunston. The school, students and faculty made the whole teaching thing like new again, So, I worked another eleven years at Gunston and called retirement for the second time in 2011. After some subbing I went back and filled my old position for half a semester while the school hunted for another replacement, and the headmaster gave me recognition for yet a third retirement. That was followed by more subbing clear up until the pandemic made education a completely different thing. I am now OFFICIALLY retired, or at least I think,

In the days of SOB, I was in another RV Club, FCRV or Family Campers & RVers, where I served some offices and edited the Chapter newsletter. When I joined Delmarva, the Club included a couple people, who were also in FCRV, and they liked the newsletter I did there. Knowing that the current editor wanted a break, they suggested that I take the position. All that was 2012 and we've had some success. As editor of the newsletter takes a good amount of time, I have stayed away from other offices, save Trustee.

Whatever name, WBCCI, or Airstream Club, International, I have learned that membership pays way more value than the dollar figure would suggest. The people make it what it is, and tie into a quality line of RV.







RALLY FEES – \$265 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$125 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you provide your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation during registration.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the Rally are entered into a prize drawing. Gift certificates for parts and service will be drawn with a total of \$2,000 in prizes to be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA – In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2021. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after dusk may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.
