(hamboneto@gmail.com) by March15 so I can give them a count for food planning.



State Park Full? Try this.....

Have you been excited about camping at a Florida State Park or other public campground only to be disappointed when you find it is full? If so, then you may want to try this link to secure a site as soon as an opening appears.

https://reserve.wanderinglabs.com

This website monitors popular campground reservation websites looking for new availabilities every few minutes. Tell them where and

when you want to camp. When one matches your request, it notifies you via email or txt msg.

If you are willing to pay for an annual Premium Membership, then the benefits are they check twice as often (every 3-5 minutes), no pausing (free version pauses every week), and up to 500 Text alerts. Cost \$15-50 per year (depending what you think this service is worth).

Several Florida Airstream Club members have tried it a were excited to find it worked! They were able to get into Fort Desoto Park near Tampa over New Year's weekend.

The site was created by Tim Watson, who lives full-time with his wife in an Airstream, so they could stay in popular campgrounds without planning months in advance.

Favorite Apps for Camping, Part Three - Restaurants and Things To Do

We looked at navigation and campground apps in previous newsletters. This article highlights some apps that can help you find good places to eat and things to do while on the road.

Two apps tend to lead the pack in this category. They are TripAdvisor and Yelp. Both appear to be battling for the position of the "Swiss Army Knife" of reviews as they cover restaurants, hotels, flights and things to do. I get the feeling from using these apps that Yelp targets a younger crowd than TripAdvisor.

TripAdvisor reports that more than 490 million unique visitors use their site every month. They don't tell us how many of those visitors found what they were looking for.

In addition to restaurants, TripAdvisor reviews things to do and will help you reserve a flight or hotel room.

Yelp's database covers many things. If you need a plumber, physician, painter, photographer or a pharmacist, you will find their reviews on Yelp. As your parents used to say, if you specialize in everything, you will end up doing well in nothing. Yelp is worth checking, but we look at it only if TripAdvisor came up empty.

Another app that features user reviews of restaurants is FourSquare. Our Garmin GPS always refers to FourSquare when it finds a restaurant along our route. FourSquare can be helpful if you are using your GPS to see what is at the next exit.

Zomato has the smallest number of users and, by default the fewest reviews. This app was originally called UrbanSpoon and was our favorite. It was purchased by an Asian company and it suddenly became harder to search for restaurants. While we still have Zomato on our phones, we usually find what we are looking for in TripAdvisor or Yelp.

Of course, the biggest database of restaurants and things to do is Google. You are already an expert on Google and know how to find these types of reviews using it.

RoadTrippers is an app that fits this category. It helps you find interesting and sometimes quirky things to do along your route. It is always fun to see what RoadTrippers is going to come up with.
