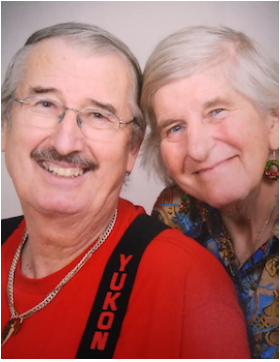

Wandering Wyoming Caravan June 28- July 17, 2020



We will begin our journey immediately following the International Rally in **Loveland, CO** on June 28th. We will travel to **Estes Park at Mary's Lake, CO**. We will be here until the 2nd of July. This should give ample time to tour **Rocky Mountain National Park** and to get to know each other. We will plan carpools for all who wish.

A special challenge activity will be to drive the **Old Fall River Road**. The speed limit is 15mph and the drive is 11 miles. Not for the faint of heart! A breakfast is planned on the morning of the 29th and will be hosted by me and my lovely wife, Cheryl.

We depart Estes Park on the morning of July 3rd to travel 283 miles to the Junction West RV Park in **Grand Junction, CO**. Here we will do a 23 mile drive through the **Colorado National Monument** and celebrate the 4th of July. We are planning a GAM (Get Acquainted Meeting) based on the number of people.

Departing Grand Junction on the 5th we will travel 105 miles to **Arches National Park**. We will camp at Moab Rim Campark. Getting up bright and early to avoid the very busy mid-morning traffic we will explore the beautiful sights of Arches. I have planned an extra day for some rest and relaxation. We will leave on the morning of the 8th.

Well rested, we will drive 269 mile to Century RV Park in the bustling city of **Ogden, UT**. On July 9th we will visit the Hill Aerospace Museum.

Departing on the 10th, we head Northeast to Sleeping Bear Campground in **Lander, WY** where we will stay 2 days. Here we will tour the Museum of the American West. Leaving on the 12th of July we will caravan for 163 miles to Cody , WY.

They are so many things to do in Cody, WY and **Yellowstone National Park** that we have four days in this wild West city. We plan to carpool to Yellowstone on the 13th as it is approximately 50 miles to the gate. The second day plan to attend the rodeo in Cody that runs all summer long. We plan to have an excursion to the Buffalo Bill Center of the West (\$18.75). An additional carpool into Yellowstone is also on the schedule.

After the busy time at Cody we will travel 214 miles to Ft Casper Campground in **Casper, WY**. This is only an overnight stay to rest up for the final 235 miles ending up back in Loveland, CO at the Riverview RV Resort. Your reservations should be made for the number of days you wish to attend Frontier Days in Cheyenne, WY. The Caravan ends here.

Caravan Equipment List

Equipment to carry on a caravan:

1. Drinking water supply equipment including:
 - (2) or more “White” drinking water hoses (NO RUBBER) 5/8” x 25 ft.
 - (1) or more hose “Y’s”
 - (1) water thief
 - (1) water pressure regulator (if not built-in)
 - (1) 5 gallon water can or clean bucket and funnel (to fill water tank when there is no pressure).
2. Waste water disposal equipment including:
 - (1) “Green” waste water hose, plainly marked “FOR WASTE WATER ONLY”, 3/4” x 25’ with male fitting cut off,(1) waste water holding container with vent tube (NO OPEN CONTAINERS).
3. Sanitary waste equipment: (1) 4-ft. sewer hose(1) 8- or 10-ft. sewer hose is desirable.
4. Electrical equipment including:
 - (1) or more 50 ft. 3-wire cord, 10 or 12 gauge, (10 gauge preferred) with Ubar grounding plug and receptacle
 - (1) adapter trailer plug to U-bar ground plug
 - extra supply of fuses for trailer/motorhome battery system.
5. Emergency equipment including: shovel, light crow bar, set of reflectors, a supply of fuses, fire extinguisher.
6. Other equipment including: wood or metal blocks and wedges for leveling trailer/motorhome, Flagpole, 3’x 5’ U.S. flag.

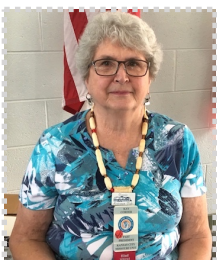
