Region 1 Rally

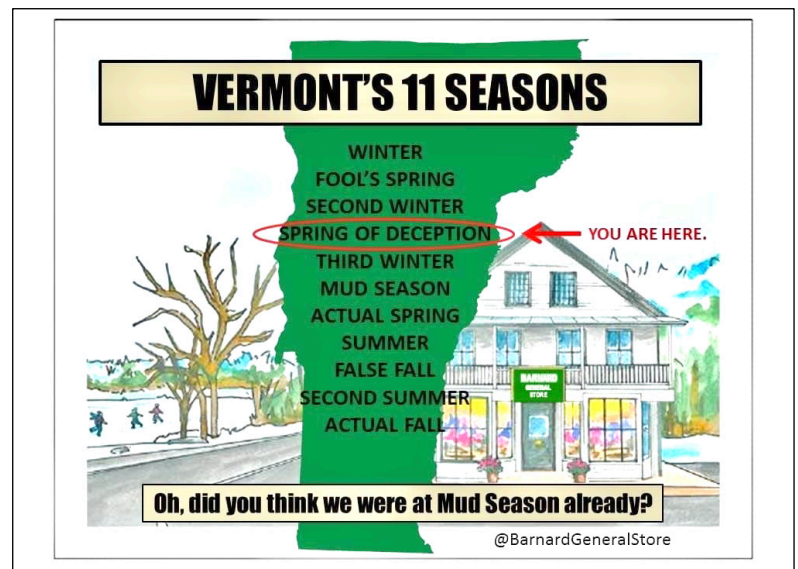
June 17-20 in Northampton, MA is for Airstreamers from all the New England states, northern New York and Quebec. For continuing updates on attractions, activities and response to
