First, I'd like to communicate the results of the ballot for changes to the Constitution of the MN Unit.

For Item 1: (change constitution to read: a notice containing the proposed amendment or amendments will be emailed to all members that have email, or first class mail to those without email at least 15 days prior to the meeting) passed as follows: 28 for the amendment, 3 against.

For Item 2: (change Unit name from MN Unit of WBCCI to MN Airstream Unit) passed as follows: 32 for, 0 against, 1 abstention.

The Unit name change now goes to Region 7 to be forwarded to the IBT for their next meeting for approval. Thanks to everyone who responded to the Ballot mailing!

Our Unit Constitution needs approval by the Unit every 5 years: we will be doing this at our Fall Installation Rally in September.

I am busy planning the Spring and Fall Rally's. Spring Rally will be in Pipestone, MN. We're waiting to hear back from the campground as to when people can start calling for reservations. We will send out a notice once we hear from them.

I'm struggling with location for the Fall Rally. I found a place in Tower, MN, but it's a little pricey for what we usually pay. (I REALLY don't want to get yelled at for price). 

Salmon Party Log

1 1lb. can Red Salmon

18 oz. package cream cheese, softened

2 tsp. Finely grated onion

1 tsp. prepared Horseradish (fresh ground-not with mayo)

1/4 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. Liquid Smoke (flavoring)

1/2 cup chopped pecans

3 TBS. snipped parsley

Drain and flake Salmon removing skin & bones. Combine Salmon with next 6 ingredients; mix thoroughly. Chill several hours. Combine pecans & parsley. Shape Salmon mixture in 8 by 2 inch log; roll in nut mixture; chill well. Pass crackers.


