Kay's Kommunique

It's not my fault! Really! I took down the "Let It Snow" sign as soon as I realized that Mother Nature was taking it as a challenge. Didn't help. Snow is so deep in our yard, that we'd lose the dog if we didn't keep shoveling out a spot for his bathroom. Poor baby can't see over the top of the drifts. At least March is coming in like a lion. There's hope for the end of the month.

One of the things I was charged with at the fall meeting was to buy a coffee urn and a hot water urn for the Club. The hot water urn was easy: 30 cups, easy to use. The coffee urn was another matter entirely. I have definitely learned a lot about coffee urns. I wanted to make sure I got something that would last a long time, and work well. I wanted one that made 50 - 75 cups of coffee, was stainless steel, and had really good reviews. I went to several sites, read many reviews, and finally made a choice which arrived and works. But, really, you think, how hard could this be? Well, let me tell you, there's a lot of thought that has to go into this. Did you know, for example, that a cup of coffee by some of these manufacturers, is 3.5 ounces. Really? How many people do you know that drink a 3.5

ounce cup of coffee? There are definitely no Airstreamers I know that do. We drink 12 ounce cups. The bigger the better. So I had to factor that in as I'm looking at an urn that the manufacturer says makes 75 3.5 oz cups. That's really only 32 8 oz cups. You see what I mean. So, I ended up with a coffee urn that makes "110 cups" (at 5.3 oz per cup for this brand) but really makes 72.5 normal person cups at 8 oz., or 48.5 Airstreamer cups at 12 oz . It has 5 stars though and met all the other parameters I set up. It was also well within the budget I was given. I even have enough left over to buy plastic sealable bins to store them in at the Park. We will try them out at the Spring Rally along with the new griddles!

If the snow ever melts (I'm still hopeful it's "when"), I'm planning on spending a day at the Airstream Park, going through the Club shed, and making an inventory of the major stuff in it. I think that will help me now, and Presidents and rally organizers of the future, to know what's there. I will try out all the coffee pots to make sure that what's there works, and get rid of what doesn't. Other than that, I'm not planning on throwing anything there away. I'll leave that to future rummagers.

As a look forward, Fall Installation Rally is going to be at Hoodoo Point Campground in Tower, MN, Sept. 12 - 15. There are many things to do in and around Tower, including the Tower-Soudan Mine State Park, the new Lake Vermillion State Park, the international Wolf and Bear Centers in Ely, and Fortune Bay Casino nearby. Hoodoo Point Campground is on Lake Vermillion, and we have some primo sites on the lake reserved for us. We will send out a separate "Save the Date" flyer with information on reserving a campsite soon.

GREETINGS! We just wanted to let you know a little bit about the Winter International Board of Trustees (IBT) meeting that was held January 21 - 25, 2019 in Robertsdale, Alabama.

John Cooper, Wisconsin Unit, took a photo of all the Region 7 members who were at the IBT. (see above)

You may recall that there are 13 Regions in the Wally Byam Airstream Club. Each region has a President and 2 Vice Presidents (VP). At the IBT, Region 7 was represented by 1st VP Jane Carmichael and 2nd VP Beth Zelten. Jane and Beth are members of the Wisconsin Unit and are Yoopers.

Region 7 has 3 Units: North Dakota Peace Garden Unit; Minnesota Airstream Club; and the Wisconsin Unit.

Each Region 7 unit has updated their Constitution and Bylaws (CBL) documents. Congratulations to those who submitted the update to CBL Chair, Tom Smithson. Tom's work has been tireless as he continues to streamline the Blue Book and keeps all units in compliance.

You may wonder what value our Constitution, By-Laws, and Policy statements have. When it was explained to me, it made more sense by looking at it this way:

Constitution: WHO we are

By-Laws: WHAT we do

Policy: HOW we do

During the IBT, your officers reviewed motions, discussed ideas for improvement of Blue Book language, and voted on several issues. Their work culminated in the approval to develop an improved website and internet communication. This project will start with Phase 1 and will improve the ease of finding information on the Wally Byam Airstream Club website.

A popular motion passed to allow all units to submit their requests to change unit names, unit badges, unit flags, directly to their Region President.

If the requested change complies with the Wally Byam Airstream Club requirements, our Corporate Manager, Lori Plummer will obtain approval from the Airstream Corp officers/legal team. The Airstream name is very protected and approval must be provided to use that name.

Region Officers at the IBT involved the rally attendees in each workshop, education seminar, and training. Of course, there were some fine meals for all along with social hours. Due to the proximity to New Orleans, LA and Mobile, AL, beads were generously provided. The Excelsior band jazzed the Cajun and Mardi Gras spirit for all.
