May 14 – 17, 2020 * Preston, Minnesota * Register by May 1, 2020

JOIN US FOR OUR SPRING RALLY IN PRESTON, MN AT MAPLE SPRINGS CAMPGROUND NEAR FORESTVILLE/MYSTERY CAVE STATE PARK.

High points of our rally will include:

- ✤ A Scenic Tour of Mystery Cave.
- A tour of Historic Forestville (Historic Forestville was once the center of a thriving rural community until it fell into decline after the railroad passed it by in 1868. The historic town includes a fully-stocked general store, farm and homestead with original artifacts.
- Dinner out on Saturday evening at the Branding Iron Restaurant.

Optional activities:

- Visit the National Trout Center where they have offered to teach a group of us to fish (form your own group).
- Go trout fishing (The Minnesota Trout Association has laid out a self-guided 9-hole trout fishing course along a .8 mile reach of blue ribbon trout water in the South Branch Root River).
- Visit Amish Country! Preston is 11 miles from Harmony, home to Minnesota's largest Amish settlement, where you can take tours and purchase from Amish shops.
- ➤ Go **bicycling** on Preston's 60 miles of paved trails in Bluff Country.
- Go kayaking or canoeing on the Root River.
- > Visit the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery.

<u>We will gather on **THURSDAY, MAY 14TH** at Maple Springs Campground, where most sites are \$35/night for water and electric (a few sites also have sewer for \$40/night). Please call in your campground reservations to Andy at 507-951-8876. PLEASE TELL HIM YOU ARE WITH THE AIRSTREAM RALLY GROUP so he will place you in the right area. NOTE: Cell service is spotty in this area, so we will try to provide you with pertinent information (maps, etc.) ahead of time.</u>

FRIDAY, MAY 15TH will be a day to spend on your own or in groups, enjoying the above optional activities, or whatever else you'd like. Bring food to share for potluck supper that evening.

<u>SATURDAY, MAY 16TH</u> We will tour Historic Forestville and Mystery Cave then have supper at the Branding Iron Restaurant in Preston (Pay for your own and order from the menu – they serve everything from steak to burgers to chicken to fish).

SUNDAY, MAY 17TH we will start the morning with our famous crockpot oatmeal breakfast, then head home after goodbyes.

Ramble number 1 - the ongoing saga of the bumper repair. Actually, we installed it last weekend on the 65degree sunny Sunday afternoon, so I guess it's no longer qualified as a saga... We're quite pleased with how it turned out. I'll include pics of the dent removal process once we get there.



Ramble number 2 - I have not done any woodworking over the winter this year for all sorts of reasons including having a bad cold and pneumonia for an extended period of time. Certainly seemed like a really, really long time. On the plus side, I have been spending time on my model railroad. I've built a decrepit barn and a gas station among other things.





I have set up a campground with a couple of Airstreams of course. To put things in perspective, those airstreams are about $1\frac{1}{2}$ " long.

This is all work in progress. The ground is 2" pink foam insulation board with brown paint on it, so it's kind of a Mars landscape right now.



I just finished building 3 little houses, shown below sitting on my hand.




They, like every other building, have a temporary place on my layout.



The shingles are individual rows of laser cut adhesive backed paper that took about an hour per house to apply.



Kay has insanity quilting projects, and I now have an insanity bridge building project. I'm hand building a trestle bridge out of itty-bitty strips of wood. $1/8" \times 1/16"$, $1/8" \times 1/8"$, and $1/8" \times 3/32"$ thick.



Eventually, track will run over the top of the bridge. Not quite there yet...



Here's a picture of my fingertips to show the size of the bridge. I made two of these, one for each end of the trestle to span over the two tracks it needs to cross.



Ramble number 3 - I'm scheduled to travel to Pennsylvania for work to do an install the week of April 6th. I'm wondering if that will really happen or not. And if it does, will I be flying or driving? Sounds like if I fly, the plane will be pretty empty. Update - trip is cancelled. ©
