For example, what modifications have you made or had done to your Airstream? Something simple like installing an extra shelf, replacing furniture with something that works better for you, etc.



BREADS

English Muffins in a Loaf

5 cups unsifted flour 1/4 tsp. baking soda

2 pkgs. active dry yeast 2 cups milk

1 T. sugar 1/2 cup water

2 tsp. salt

Cornmea1

MICROWAVE:

Combine 3 cups flour, undissolved yeast, sugar, salt and baking soda. Heat milk and water until very warm (120° -130°F). Add to dry ingredients and beat well. Stir in remaining 2 cups flour to make a stiff batter. Spoon into two $8-1/2 \times 4-1/2 \times 2-1/2$ -inch or 9 x 5 x 3-inch loaf dishes that have been greased and sprinkled with cornmeal. Sprinkle tops with cornmeal. Cover and let rise in a warm place, free from drafts, for 45 minutes. Microwave (high power) each loaf for 6 minutes 30 seconds. (Crusts will be pale in color.) Allow to rest 5 minutes before removing. Cool. oned and 1/2 cup grated Parmegan or

To serve, slice and toast.

CONVENTIONAL RANGE:

Prepare as above, except increase the white flour by 1 cup when stirring in the second addition of flour to make a stiff batter. Bake at 400°F for 25 minutes. Remove from pans and cool.

VARIATIONS:

Whole Wheat Loaf: Substitute 2 cups unsifted whole wheat flour for 2 cups white flour and add 3/4 cup dried currants when combining dry ingredients in traditional loaf recipe.

Garlic Loaf: Add 2 tablespoons chopped parsley and 1-1/2 teaspoons garlic powder to traditional loaf recipe when combining dry ingredients.

Cherry Caramel Ring

Microwave Time: 8-1/2 to 10-3/4 Minutes Total

1/4 cup butter
1/2 cup brown sugar (packed)
2 T. light corn syrup
1/2 cup pecan halves

1/4 cup maraschino cherries,
quartered
1 pkg. buttermilk biscuits

Place butter in 8" round dish. Microwave at High 1/2 to 3/4 minutes until melted.

Sprinkle sugar over butter and add corn syrup. Stir well with fork. Place drinking glass in center of dish. Sprinkle with pecans and cherries.

Arrange biscuits over mixture in dish in petal shape, squeezing to fit, if necessary. Microwave at Medium 6 to 8 minutes, rotating dish 1/2 turn after 3 minutes. Remove glass and invert onto serving plate. Let dish stand over rolls a few minutes so remaining syrup in dish may drizzle over rolls. Serve warm.

Makes 1 - 8" Ring

Bran Muffins

2 cups all-bran cereal 2-1/2 cups flour
1-1/2 cups sugar 3 tsp. soda
1 tsp. salt 1 cup chopped nuts
2 eggs 1/2 cup cooking oil
2 cups buttermilk Raisins (optional)

In a large bowl mix together cereal, flour, sugar, soda, salt, and chopped nuts. Combine eggs, cooking oil, and buttermilk and mix well. Add liquid to dry ingredients. This mixed batter will keep up to six weeks stored and covered in the refrigerator. Microwave individual muffins by placing a paper muffin liner in a plastic solo cup holder, a custard cup, a microwave cupcaker or put a paper liner in a "ring" cut from a styrofoam cup. Microwave 1 muffin 30 seconds. 6 muffins will take 3 minutes.
