There will be no group meals except for one optional catered dinner served on-site


This rally is for the adventurous! There's more to see and do than you'll be able to do.

OLD BUSINESS (from Early 2020)

Some members have asked what the outcome has been for some of the changes enacted by the previous Executive Board. The current Executive Board has addressed those changes as follows . . .

1. Idaho Dues increase from \$15.00 to \$25.00

The previous Executive Board changed the Annual Membership Dues for the Idaho Club from \$15.00 to \$25.00. However, this change was never communicated to the Airstream Club International Headquarters. So when Idaho Airstream Club members renewed their 2021 membership, they were charged \$15.00. The Executive Board has chosen to leave the Annual Idaho Club Membership Dues at \$15.00 and will re-evaluate a dues increase for 2022.

2. Idaho Credit Card for Rally reservations:

A credit card and a debit card were acquired for the Idaho Airstream Club with Larry Conn as the signatory. The Executive Board is investigating if or how we can remove Larry Conn from the cards since he is no longer a member of the Idaho Airstream Club. Or we may decide to cancel the cards until we are better prepared to implement any changes to our current Rally registration processes.

3. Changes to the Rally registration processes:

In 2020, the Idaho Airstream Club saw many dramatic changes including the Executive Board changeover in membership, the COVID restrictions, and reservation requirements for Idaho State Parks. As a result, the Executive Board has tabled discussions on Rallies at Idaho State Parks, the Rally Fee roundup amount, and pre-payment of the entire Rally Fee at the time of registration pending a revamping of the entire Rally registration process. The Arizona and Oregon Clubs have Rally registration processes that appear to work well and we are currently evaluating them.

4. Eliminating the Free Rally Coupon:

The previous Executive Board eliminated the Free Rally Coupon that was given to new members to encourage Rally attendance. The Executive Board has upheld this decision citing that we have no Membership Chair and there is confusion over what "Free" really means. The Executive Board felt is better to leave this Idaho Club benefit for re-evaluation at a later date.

NEW BUSINESS (from 2021)

1. Executive Board Meetings:

The Executive Board has met several times this year; two meetings via Zoom and most recently in person in May. Formal and informal Executive Board meetings will continue until the new Idaho Club Officers are installed in August. Each of these meetings has included lively and lengthy discussions of how to best move the Idaho Airstream Club forward

2. Regular Idaho Club meetings:

The next regular Idaho Airstream Club meeting will be held at the Idaho Airstream Club Installation Rally at Canyon Pines RV Resort in Pollock, ID. on August 26 - 29. Please make plans to attend.

3. Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer has reported that the Idaho Airstream Club has three accounts; a checking account that is used for general operations and has a balance of approximately \$11,000; a money market account with a balance of approximately \$3,000; a caravan account with a balance of a couple hundred dollars. 2021 expenses have been limited to the monthly storage unit fees.
