November Palm Springs Rally

The Las Vegas Airstream Club's November Rally is scheduled for November 3-8, 2021 at the Palm Springs/Joshua Tree KOA. Located just 10 miles from Palm Springs and 45 minutes to the entrance of Joshua Tree National Park.

If we get at least ten rigs we qualify for a 10% discount on the rate.

Attendees will need to make their own reservations and let the KOA know you are with the Las Vegas Airstream Club. You will be required to pay a 1 night deposit. There is a 30 day cancellation policy for refund minus \$10 cancellation fee per site. If you must cancel later than the 30 days you will forfeit the first nights cost. You may make your reservation by calling 800-562-9861 and letting them know it is the Palm Desert/Joshua Tree KOA that you are wanting.

Traveling in his vintage Airstream quickly made him find out that we are looking at an endless source of beautiful and honest products from local farmers and farmers markets around us. Bart is born and raised in Belgium Europe and that is what they do out there, sourcing eggs from a farmer, buying fresh honey from the local beehive and yes, picking up live chickens and create a fresh meal.



Camping and cooking go hand in hand like salt and pepper. We all need to eat and Bart looks at it from a social perspective as well. Him and his girlfriend Iris raise a family of 4 young kids and he is all about getting the kids involved in cooking meals. Even cleaning veggies and doing dishes, Bart and Iris teach them how to cut a carrot, dice an onion and sear a beautiful steak like it should be done. Those are the memories that last forever at campgrounds in front of their beloved 1964 Airstream Globetrotter.

Well, here you have it! Some Belgian Fries and Beer mussels

Time: 30 min - 2 servings

Ingredients:

4-5 large golden potatoes to cut fries
I large onion
I garlic clove
I bottle of beer (Stella Artois works well)
I/2 cup of mayonnaise
I/2 stack of celery
3/4 pounds of cultivated large as possible mussels
I/4 cup heavy cream



Cook Belgian fries twice. First 6 minutes, let them rest while you prepare mussels.

Cook fries a second time until they "float" in the oil.

Shake them off and season with salt if you prefer that.

Mussels

Easy peasy:

Start with a good spoon of butter on the bottom of your pot.

Rinse mussels 3-4 times and add them on top of your butter.

Cut onion and celery in small half inch dices/ chunks. Add garlic, heavy cream, bottle of beer, salt and pepper.

Keep covered with a lid and turn the heat up as high as possible. Now watch until you see steam coming up. That is the exact moment when you pick up the pot with two kitchen towels and shake it around. Back on the stove and now cook your fries for the second time. At this point wait until you see steam again and that indicates roughly when your fries are cooked as well. Take mussels off the stove, add another chunk of butter and shake them again, put the lid back on and serve asap.



The mussels opened up and that is when they are ready to be served

Dress your plate with fries on one side, mussels and veggies on the other side and mayo on your fries.
