

Good afternoon to everyone except people who don't gain weight when they eat whatever they want!!!

Italian Delight

This will become your new favorite recipe.

- 4 Tablespoons of butter
- 1 Rotisserie chicken (deboned)
- 2 Cloves of garlic, minced.
- 1/8 tsp. Red Pepper flakes.
- 1 1/2 Cups of water with 2 chicken bouillon cubes dissolved.
- 1 large onion (julienne-cut)
- 1 bell pepper (julienne-cut)

- 1 cup of heavy cream
- 1/4 cup sun-dried tomatoes chopped
- 1/2 cup of parmesan cheese
- 1 teaspoon basil
- 1 small jar of Classico Sun-Dried Tomato Pesto
- 1 12 oz pack of Hidden Veggie spaghetti noodles

Place butter, onion, bell pepper, pepper flakes, tomatoes and garlic and cook until tender. Add bullion water, chicken, basil, jar of pesto and cream. Stir until hot and then add the parmesan cheese. Spoon over cooked noodles. All ingredients can be found at your local Walmart.
