. In January the IBT approved changing the membership period from calendar year to an anniversary year basis, based on 12 months from the original join date. This will be implemented beginning July 1, 2021. All current members will have an anniversary date of January 1st. New members on/after July 1 will be on a true anniversary schedule (i.e. if a member joins July 17, 2021, their membership is active from July 17, 2021 through July 16, 2022). HQ will send out renewal notifications about 120 days before the expiration date. The pro-rated dues system for new members will end June 30, 2021. Members will be able to renew their WBCCI and club membership at the same time. Lifetime members will be included in the notification process and will need to renew through HQ at which time they will select and pay unit/club dues.
