MAAC President's Message



Things are starting to open up for camping! This past weekend Ingrid and I attended our first Maintenance Rally in Centreville, MD. There was a total of 37 campers with their Airstreams and two additional folks who visited the rally to get a sense of what all they involved. MAAC attendees included Ingrid and I, Flora Barrett and Myron Brenner, and new members John and Angela Shields.

I have to say that the rally was a very worthwhile endeavor, especially for me as a new owner. I got all sorts of tips on using and maintaining my Airstream, everything from backing up my trailer to what tools are needed. Chuck Helwig, from the Delmarva Club, was especially helpful to all of us.

We were provided with a checklist of all the things needed to get your Airstream ready for the coming season. The checklist included lug nut tightening, tire inflation, fire extinguisher assessment, battery and propane testing, lubricating window and door seals, lock maintenance, hinge examination, and ball and hitch connections. It reminded me of things I needed to do but I had overlooked, such as testing the inflation of my spare tire. I highly recommend attending the 2022 Maintenance Rally, especially if you are new to Airstreams.

I have been considering venues for having our own MAAC Rally later this year. I have explored various sites in MD, WV, and PA, but they are all pretty well booked up for the rest of this summer. But there is one location where we could hold a rally in October. That location is Little Bennett County Park in Clarksburg, MD. Little Bennett is a beautiful park in Montgomery County. It is about 12 miles south of Frederick, MD and 30 miles northwest of Washington, DC. It is right in the middle of many restaurants, historical sites, and cultural locations.

So, we are going to sponsor an Autumn Rally at Little Bennett Park from October 8-10, 2021. The Park has 5 camping loops, but only Loop D has spots for travel trailers. As of today, April 28, there are 17 sites available, all with full hookups (water, electric, and sewer). Three of the available sites are pull-through and pets are allowed at all sites. The price per night is \$55 for Montgomery County residents and \$66 for all others. More information is available at: [Little Bennett Campground - Montgomery Parks](#). 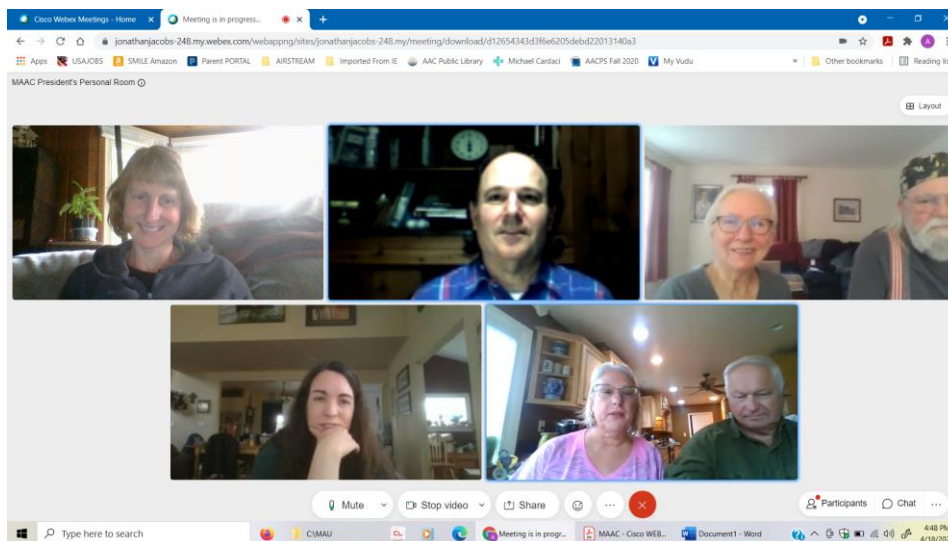

REGISTRATION

RALLY FEES – \$265 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$125 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you provide your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation during registration.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the Rally are entered into a prize drawing. Gift certificates for parts and service will be drawn with a total of \$2,000 in prizes to be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA – In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2021. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after dusk may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY – Refund requests received by May 22, 2021, will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests after May 23, 2021, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after July 3, 2021. *If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance.*

RALLY PARKING DATES – General parking is tentatively scheduled to begin around July 14th. Parking dates will be sent via email in Spring 2021. Caravans of 5 or more need to contact HQ at rally@airstreamclub.org for available arrival dates.

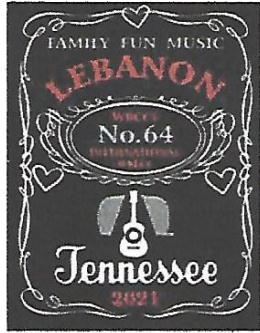
