Shawnee State Park is between US Routes 30 and 31 about 10 miles west of Bedford, PA. The actual address is Schellsburg, PA. It is located at the foot of the Allegheny Mountains, it has a swimming and boating lake, playgrounds for kids, hiking trails, and several hundred camping spaces that are well wooded and far apart. The basic price is \$27.00 per night but that fee can go up for weekends, out-of-staters, and what amenities are at the site you choose. There are also discounts for seniors and the disabled. Shawnee fills up quickly so you need to make reservations well in advance. You can begin making reservations 11 months before the rally. So, please make your reservations starting **July 12, 2021**. We will keep you informed of other rally opportunities that may arise in the near future because we are anxious to get back together soon!

Wandering Labs Review


In the March edition of The Grapevine Randy Hill wrote an article about how to find campsites when on the road. It's becoming increasingly difficult to score a desired campground on the dates you want or need. The industry is booming and sales of RVs are up 30%! But there's been no change in the number of campgrounds or campsites to match this explosion. We will all notice it this year and likely for the next few years. Charlie and I spent three weeks in Arkansas in April and experienced this as well. We had absolutely no difficulty getting a site Sunday—Thursday but good luck finding a state campsite on Friday or Saturday. We resorted to private campgrounds for the weekend.

Our club experienced this with the upcoming event at Sampson State Park. All of our reserved club sites sold out (WHOO HOO!!) and we had one member who wanted to attend but missed getting the last site by hours. They reached out to me just in case I heard of an opening. It was the perfect time to try out Wandering Labs at

<u>https://wanderinglabs.com/new</u>. Here's what happened..

After confirming with Reserve America there were no available sites at Sampson I signed up. It is free to use. I plugged in the dates that I needed, along with trailer length. Then I waited!! Within 18 hours the first site opened up. I was notified by email. I immediately contacted the member needing the site and they scored!! I decided to see how many more sites might become available. As of writing this on 5/12 there have been at least 10 sites that have opened for our scheduled weekend!! I'm sold.

For a donation between \$15 and \$50 you can upgrade to a Premium Membership. With your donation the upgrade includes: unlimited requests, scanning for sites twice as often and every minute for high demand locations, no pause in services (free versions pauses every week) and up to 500 text alerts. Charlie and I are planning to upgrade to Premium as we feel if a mere \$25 nets us a fabulous location on the dates we want we are \$\$ ahead. We'll let you know next fall how it worked out.

REGISTRATION

RALLY FEES – \$265 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$125 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you provide your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation during registration.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the Rally are entered into a prize drawing. Gift certificates for parts and service will be drawn with a total of \$2,000in prizes to be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA – In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2021. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after dusk may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY – Refund requests received by May 22, 2021, will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests after May 23, 2021, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after July 3, 2021. *If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance.*

RALLY PARKING DATES – General parking is tentatively scheduled to begin around July 14th. Parking dates will be sent via email in Spring 2021. Caravans of 5 or more need to contact HQ at rally@airstreamclub.org for available arrival dates.
