MAAC President's Message



The summer is here and, so far, it has been pretty nice. I hope you had a chance to get out with your Airstream and enjoy the good weather and the great outdoors!

I must apologize if you tried to join our virtual meeting on June 27 but failed to be admitted. Due to a technical glitch we were unable to hold the meeting. I need to make some adjustments or develop a backup plan to make sure the meetings can proceed as planned. So, I will try to make up for the missed information by including it in this month's newsletter.

First and foremost, we have received approvals from Airstream Club International (ACI) for our new logo and flag. I sent the proposed flag graphic to our members via email on May 29, 2021 (the logo graphic was approved by our members in October, 2020) and asked everyone to vote on it. We received 15 votes for approval and no disapprovals. Based on that positive result, I asked our Region 2 President, Richard Short, to make a motion to ACI Headquarters that our logo and flag be officially approved. Mr. Short made that motion on June 2 and in an email dated June 8 from Lori Plummer, Corporate Manager, ACI, she advised me that both the logo and flag were officially approved! I thank all the folks who voted and I especially thank Flora Barrett who developed the graphics for both the logo and flag.

Our Autumn Rally is still on for October 8-10, 2021 at Little Bennet Regional Park in Clarksburg, MD. There are still four campsites available. I hope our members will take advantage of this opportunity and reserve the remaining four spots. Since the price for a campsite is relatively high, there will be no rally fee. By the way, the price for Montgomery County, MD residents is \$55 per night and \$66 per night for all non-county residents. Pets are welcomed as are well behaved kids! As I mentioned in last month's President's Message, we have made plans for a June 10-12, 2022, rally at Shawnee State Park near Bedford, PA. We have also made arrangements for a rental hall, a square dancer caller, and a caterer for a barbecue dinner on the night of Saturday, June 11. We hope to have a good turnout and I invited some of the PA airstream clubs to join us. I think it will be a good way to start the 2022 camping season.



Shawnee State Park is between US Routes 30 and 31 about 10 miles west of Bedford, PA. The actual address is Schellsburg, PA. It is located at the foot of the Allegheny Mountains, it has a swimming and boating lake, playgrounds for kids, hiking trails, and several hundred camping spaces that are well wooded and far apart. The basic price is \$27.00 per night but that fee can go up for weekends, out-of-staters, and what amenities are at the site you choose. There are also discounts for seniors and the disabled. Shawnee fills up quickly so you need to make reservations well in advance. You can begin making reservations 11 months before the rally. So, please make your reservations starting July 12, 2021. Windshear Receives a Face Lift

Over the past three years, we upgraded the function and style of our Airstream, whom we have affectionally named Windshear, after a silver dragon in the movie, "How To Train Your Dragon." The progress has been a labor of love, time, and patience.

My husband, Joe, and I purchased a used 2007 Safari Special Edition 25 FB, 75th anniversary addition. The





75th anniversary addition. The first item on the list to upgrade was the lounge area cushions for style and comfort. The original cushions were fabric so we upgraded to Ultraleather cushions to reduce allergens and for ease of cleaning for our 130-pound Newfoundland dog. I contacted Airstream customer service who stated the cushion size was the same as the newer models. This was an easy win so we were able to purchase new cushions.

The second upgrade we did at the same time were new beds. Although the original floor plan had twin beds, the previous owners removed the night stand and installed plywood across the twin bed platforms to make a king bed. The original cabinets under the twin beds were not removed. We removed the king bed platform and converted the beds back to twin beds.









I made decorative pillows which came in handy against the cold aluminum skin. We tuck them along the twin beds and lounge area. No more cold skin during the night! I also made window sashes for the curtains and added a backing on the curtains to keep the trailer cooler or warmer, depending on the season. I also designed kitchen towels, a clock, garden flag, and picnic table blanket for our enjoyment. These little touches added a sense of personalization in our home on wheels.

We upgraded the furnace and water heater doors and exhaust fan to the stainless-steel options. We also had a lower custom screen door guard made that I helped design.

Although Windshear is a 75th anniversary edition, she did not have the 75th anniversary emblem. Hunting down the emblem proved difficult. Airstream no longer carried them. I contacted numerous dealerships across the country and finally found one.



The next projects were for function, which Joe methodically tackled. The first projects were "relatively minor". Joe upgraded the tires and wheels to 16" Michelin LTX Defenders, upgraded the electrical plugs to the Smart Plugs, added Dometic Ultra Breeze fan covers on the roof, upgraded the original skylight to the Maxim skylight, upgraded the toilet to the Dometic 310, added a Progressive Industries hard wired EMS, and added a WeBoost. He changed all lightening to LED bulbs. Joe then hard wired four fans, one at each bed,



and two at the dinette to keep the trailer cool. The kids don't complain that it's hot! Joe also installed a new Dometic Penquin II AC/Heat pump and a Micro Air Easy Start.

The next functional projects were major that required time and patience, especially since we work full-time. This is where the patience came in because Joe again did all the heavy lifting. He installed new axles with minor help from myself and our teenage kids. He designed and installed a solar system and upgraded the electrical wiring to accommodate the solar system. He installed four 100 watt Zamp Obsidian Solar Panels, four Battle Born Lithium Batteries, a Magnum 3000 watt inverter, and a Red Arc Battery Management system. The upgrades have been amazing to allow us to boondock more comfortably.





After living with the new Ultraleather cushions with the original dinette table, we decided to create a U-shape dinette seating area. Joe made a bench area that spanned the "wall" under the panoramic windows. I tracked down the Ultra leather cushion



color as Airstream has it coded differently and bought several yards. We found a local tailor/upholster who made us custom cushions for the back "wall" and seat. Joe installed a telescoping pedestal table.

The latest project that we are most proud of is new countertops and a night stand because the



wood was harvested from property. our Several 100 ft tall oak and hickory trees were struck by lightning and needed to be removed. We arranged with a tree company to saw the trees to 8 ft lengths and a local sawyer milled and kiln dried the wood. One of Joe's friends makes furniture as a hobby. He made us the new kitchen and bathroom counters, a

night stand (since we didn't have one), and a new kitchen table. The kitchen table is hinged and folds over so we can minimize the table as needed. The table, night stand, and counters are true craftsmanship and works of art.

RALLY FEES – \$265 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$125 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you provide your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation during registration.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the Rally are entered into a prize drawing. Gift certificates for parts and service will be drawn with a total of \$2,000in prizes to be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA – In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2021. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after dusk may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY – Refund requests received by May 22, 2021, will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests after May 23, 2021, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after July 3, 2021. *If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance.*

RALLY PARKING DATES – General parking is tentatively scheduled to begin around July 14th. Parking dates will be sent via email in Spring 2021. Caravans of 5 or more need to contact HQ at <u>rally@airstreamclub.org</u> for available arrival dates.
