Astronomy Note:

The Sun

The sun is 93 million miles from the earth. The sun is so big that one million planets the size of the earth could fit in the volume occupied by the sun. It is the earth's closest star, the next closest star is Proxima-Centauri whose light takes 4 years to reach earth. It would take 19,000 years for a space craft to reach Proxima-Centauri. It takes one year for the earth to orbit the sun: if you're 55 years old, you've been around the sun 55 times! (Hughes 12–15).

The Earth

The earth is "the third rock from the sun" and the 5th largest planet in our solar system. The earth is the only planet we know of that contains life. As the earth orbits the sun, it spins at 1000 mph in 24 hours, yet has the invisible force of gravity to hold things down. (Hughes 18).
