

There is an excellent dump facility available, general store, and shower facilities. Jamie, the park manager, has arranged for us to camp together in a nice section of the park. That arrangement lasts until August 31st for reservations. Past that date, the hold on spaces will be removed. We have a certain number of spaces available. Please reserve your spot. CALL, do not use the parks' online system (except to check out park site map). Tell them you are with the Minnesota Airstream Club. They know our sites and will assign you one if you do not have a preference.
