The following is a website run by a private citizen that is very useful for finding military campgrounds. These can be used by active and retired military, and also civilian employees of the military. www.militarycampgrounds.us/

<u>Airforums.com</u> and <u>vintageairstream.com</u> are two useful sites for advice and information on all sorts of Airstreams.

If you are 62 or over you can purchase a Maryland Golden Age Pass online for \$10. This pass is valid for half-price camping (includes campsites and mini-cabins, excludes full-service cabins and houses) for one site, Sunday through Thursday, excluding holidays. The pass holder must present the original pass at check-in and must be part of the camping party on that site during the entire stay The Golden Age Pass can be purchased online.

Remember that at the club website (<u>airstreamclub.org/mid-atlantic</u>) you can find old newsletters, look at activities, see officers, the membership directory, etc. You can also navigate to activity listings for other clubs or regions and lots of other Airstream information. You will have to create a login to see some of this information.
