Membership Renewal

For most of us it's that time of year: **Renew your WBCCI (and Keystone Unit) membership for 2022**. Keystone dues are \$15 for the year; WBCCI dues are \$75 for the year.

In January the IBT approved changing the membership period from calendar year to an anniversary year basis, based on 12 months from the original join date. All current members as of July 1, 2021 have an anniversary date of January 1st. New members on/after July 1 will be on a true anniversary schedule (i.e. if a member joined July 17, 2021, their membership is active from July 17, 2021 through July 16, 2022). HQ will send out renewal notifications about 120 days before the expiration date. Members can renew their WBCCI and club membership at the same time. Lifetime members will be included in the notification process and will need to renew through HQ at which time they will select and pay unit/club dues.

Please email (r_pitts@verizon.net) any questions or concerns regarding dues, **but do not send your annual or lifetime WBCCI/Keystone renewal to West Chester.** (Note this does not apply to those associate or former members who are <u>only</u> renewing their Keystone membership.)

To renew your annual or Lifetime WBCCI and Unit memberships:

Go to airstreamclub.org/current-members (Renew Your Airstream Club International Membership), login and pay on the internet (\$90 = \$75 WBCCI + \$15 Keystone, #092) (Lifetime \$15 Keystone only). Update any info as needed and renew. The renewal page should show your affiliation with Keystone making this easier. WBCCI will send us a copy of your receipt, and your Unit dues. Remember, you must renew through WBCCI by December 31, 2021 to be listed in the 2022 International Directory published in February 2022.

Alumni: If you wish to renew only your annual Keystone Unit membership:

Please send a \$15 check payable to 'WBCCI-Keystone Unit #092' to Rick Pitts, Treasurer, 930 Stoney Run Drive, West Chester, PA, 19382. Do not renew through the WBCCI website as they coordinate only for renewing WBCCI members. Please renew by December 31.
