

For the majority of our members, the 2022 Membership Renewal season has started. Below are a few highlights to remember:

- International Membership dues are \$75.00 a year.
- The primary member MUST be logged in to the member-only portal to renew online.
- Members with multiple Big Red Numbers (BRN) can renew their additional BRN in the member-only portal at the time of renewal.
- HQ is able to collect Affiliate dues for clubs IF we have been notified by the local club President or Vice President. If your club does not appear on the Affiliate Club list, this means we have not been notified.
- All Lifetime members must go through the renewal process.
- HQ will be notifying members it is time to renew by postcard, email and social media starting September 1st.
- HQ will notify Local Clubs if there is an issue contacting a member.
- The deadline for the Annual Printed Membership Directory is December 31, 2021.
- The Annual Printed Membership Directory will be published in February.
