Greetings fellow Carter Lake Rally attendees!

Sept 1, 2021

What a year it has been! Our 2021 rally is just around the corner, and we are looking forward to a fun weekend in a beautiful setting! Here are a few things you will need to

- The campground we have reserved is South Shore at Carter Lake. Due to recent cancelations, the attendee list and site assignments are still somewhat in flux. Once we get the situation stabilized, we will make that information available. At the very least, attendees can consult one of the hosts for their site assignment when they arrive. Dave & Nancy will be in Site 1, and Dayna & Michael Olivas will be in Site 12.
- There are 2 entrances to Carter Lake, on the north end and the south end. Our campground is nearest the south entrance, which is accessed from Berthoud on County Road 8E. This is the best route to access the campground. The entrance on the north side of the lake is accessed from Highway 34 west of Loveland.
- Since Carter Lake is a Larimer County Park, you will need a Larimer Parks pass. If you do not already have a Larimer Parks annual pass, you will need to buy a 3-day pass when you arrive. 3-day passes can be purchased at the North Entrance station off County Road 31 (via Carter Lake Road) for \$9 per day. A trailered boat is an additional \$9 per day. If you buy the passes at the unstaffed kiosk, you will have to buy one each day. While there is an entrance station at the South entrance, it has not been staffed during our recent visits, so the North Entrance is the best bet for obtaining a pass.
- Attached also is a PDF document with a detailed map of South Shore Campground for you to print and bring with you if you'd like. All sites are electric only. Water is available at the campground, but not at each site. There is a dump station and a water filling station near the south entrance to Carter Lake.
- If you need to cancel, please email or call Dave Czenkusch as soon as you know. We are beyond the deadline for refunds. Recent cancelations have left us with a few spots to fill. We do have a short waitlist that could evaporate quickly.
- This is mostly a Just Campin' event with a few scheduled gatherings and activities. There is a covered pavilion available for our use, but it is little far from where everyone will be camping.
- As we all know by now, masking policies have been relaxed compared to last summer. In particular, they are not required for outdoor gatherings. Still, the Delta Variant has caused a recent surge in cases, and hospital ICUs are nearly full. So, we should all exercise good judgement. If you're feeling ill or have COVID-type symptoms, please stay home.
- For additional shade at your site, you might want to bring an E-Z up for your site.
- There is no fire ban currently in effect. As usual, all wood should be purchase locally, rather than bringing in wood from outside the area. We will also have several propane fire pits available for group use in the central gathering area.
- Cellular phone and internet access in the campground is sketchy. You might need to leave the campground to get a signal.
- Alcohol is allowed in the campground, but <u>no glass containers are allowed</u>. Keep your wine bottles in your trailer!
