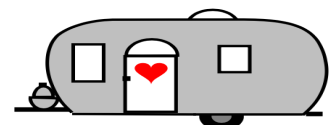

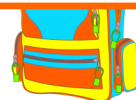

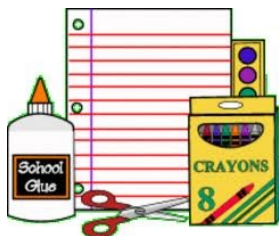
Thank You for the School Supplies!
