The President's Corner

Two years ago at a club rally in Western New York, our second rally with the club, I was approached by members of the club's executive board with a question they wanted to ask me. At the time, our club, like many Airstream clubs, was in transition with declining membership as older members got out of camping or transferred to clubs down south. Fewer new members were joining. At one of the business meetings I spoke up with ideas on how the club could grow the membership. Apparently, I made an impression, as the board asked if I would consider becoming president of the NY Finger Lakes Club.

I had a lot of ideas that I thought would help grow the club, many from our membership, as I listened to all of you - ideas like growing our social media presence with a Facebook group, changing the club's name from "Unit" to "Airstream Club" so members would know that we were a camping club and not a military unit, and updating our Constitution to reflect how we could communicate and conduct business electrically vs by the postal system. These changes, along with many others, were made possible with the support of the members of our Executive Board.

Back in the fall of 2019, no one thought our world would change so much in the next six months. All rallies were canceled and "Zoom" meetings replaced in-person meetings. Through all of this, our club found a way to safely get together in small groups as camping meet-ups replaced rallies. During this time, Diane and I got to meet many new members that have not been to a club event before who came out for a "meet-up" at one of of our awesome state parks.

As more people discovered that RVing was a safe and fun way to travel, something our members had always known, our membership started to grow. Each month we were getting notices of new Airstream owners finding our club. This has stopped the decline in membership, keeping us at about 60 Big Red Numbers as of the time I am writing this column.

Our club is in a better place now then it was two years ago, and this is all because of the great group of people that volunteer their time to keep this club moving forward. Without all of you sharing your spare time, this club could have faded away like some of the other clubs have done in the past.

It's Time for 2022 Membership Renewals!

Greetings from your Treasurer Ted Smith,

Amanda Hughes, Membership Coordinator, has informed me that WBCCI will begin to notify members directly for the 2022 membership renewal process starting September 1st by e-mail, postcard and/or social media. Members who joined prior to 2021, your expiration date remains December 31st. Members who joined after July 1, 2021 your renewal and anniversary date is the date you joined. The following may not apply to members who joined after July 1, 2021 at this time.

- International dues for 2022 are \$75.00
- NYFLAC dues remain \$10.00.
- A "members-only" self-service portal has been launched at https://airstreamclub.org/renew and members will be able to view their account.
- Payment accepted through Pay Pal or credit card.
- Affiliate members are able to renew on line at the same time.
- Life members must go through the renewal process to pay dues.
- As Treasurer I get notified when WBCCI sends your unit dues electronically to our club checking account twice a month.
- Do you have a seasonal address? To have this address included in the directory please complete the NYFLAC 2022 Dues/Directory Form found on page 10 of this newsletter.
- New members, it is helpful to have you complete the NYFLAC 2022 Dues/Directory Form as well to be sure we
 include accurate information in the 2022 NYFLAC Directory.

Members who do not wish to, or can not, renew on-line have the following options:

• Complete the dues/directory form found on page 9 of this newsletter. Send a check in the proper amount made out to WBCCI-NYFLAC to Ted Smith and I will forward the International portion to WBCCI.

- Call Amanda Hughes at WBCCI Headquarters and she will help you renew your membership over the phone with a credit card. Her number is 937-596-5211.
- Please review the NYFLAC 2021 Membership Directory and International Directory for accuracy.
- If there are no changes send the treasurer a check in the proper amount made out to NYFLAC, and a note that everything is the same as last year, and I will forward your international dues directly to WBCCI.

Past members who have sold their trailers and wish to continue receiving The Grapevine, as well as attend functions as a guest, may do so by paying club dues only.

Due to increasing postage costs our Executive Committee voted to discontinue mailing hard copies of our newsletter "The Grapevine" starting January 2022. The newsletter will continue to be electronically delivered as well as being available on our New York Finger Lakes Airstream Club Website and on our Facebook page.
