Cancellations can be made up to 3 days before for a \$10 fee. A campsite ex--a 30amp site with water is \$34/night, but with a Senior Pass the fee would be \$26.

 & cormorants. A 20- minute tour of the hydroelectric dam may be available. View construction of the larger lock next to the operating lock.

- Explore the Northern section of Land Between the Lakes:
- 1. Use the <u>Hillman Ferry Campground Hike and Bike Trail</u>, which can take you to the North Welcome Station.
- 2. Honker Trail 4.6 mi, starts back at Woodlands Nature Station and cross Honker Dam.
- 3. Hematite Trail 2.2 mi, starts back at the Woodlands Nature Station and walk around Hematite Lake.
- 4. Center Furnace Trail .3 mi, starts back at the Woodlands Nature Station and walk to an iron furnace.
- <u>5. Canal Loop Trail</u> 11 mi total and see many scenic outlooks and an Eagle nest. Can enter at one of 4 connectors.
- 6. <u>Central Hardwoods Scenic Trail</u> 11 mi spans the entire width of LBL connecting Lake Barkley and Kentucky Lake. It's fun just to walk across Kentucky Lake Bridge or Barkley Lake Bridge by leaving a car at each end. The Central Hardwoods Trail is a well-groomed, great trail.
