President's Message


My Fellow Penn-Lehighers,

Region 2 notes from the President

The IBT had a discussion on October 21, with a few updates on things being proposed for the club. In general, I think these are great changes for the club to consider, even if we don't adopt them.

There was a discussion about removing the International Rally date range from the Constitution. The problem is that there are limited venues that can support the International Rally and provide the services members request, like 30 amp electric, so the proposal is to allow the International Rally to be scheduled at a different parts of the year, so we could, for example, have International in the South in the fall when it's not as hot.

Tom Smithson, head of the Constitution and Bylaws Committee, described the possibility of allowing constitutional amendments to be voted upon by members directly, instead of via delegates.

The other topics were realigning the officer terms to match the fiscal year of the club (Aug 1-July 31), the committee investigating longer terms for the International officers has begun their work, and a proposed schedule for a quarterly IBT meeting (replacing the current mid-winter and summer meetings).

Region 2 rally update (May 19-22, 2022): As of this writing, we do not have a contract signed. However, we're in agreement with the fairgrounds on the details of the contract, so now we just need to get ink on paper. Once we get that done, we'll start planning the details. Several clubs and members have already reached out to offer help, and I very much appreciate that! We'll be putting out a call for volunteers soon.

Hello, everyone. I'm getting my notes out a bit late this month, so I apologize for missing any publishing deadlines.



Our very good Penn Lehigh friend and alumni member, George S. Beaver, Sr passed on Friday, December 10, 2021 at the age of 91. He was a patient in Geisinger Medical Center in Danville, PA .. He was taken with pneumonia and did not have the stamina to fight the infliction. He had previously had surgery. He was born June 8, 1930.

He faithfully served his country in the US Army Air Force.

He had been employed 27 years as a truck driver.

He and his wife, Mary Louise, (members of Penn Lehigh Unit WBCCI) enjoyed traveling. They spent many winters in Texas. George and Mary Louise hosted many rallies at the Numidia Airport. We have so many memories from those rallies: George's "Top Hat belly dance", Balloon rides, and airplane rides with George to mention a few. George operated an FAA Part135 Air Charter business. He was a Certified Instrument Flight Instructor and loved flying. He shared his love by teaching others. He had a great interest in preserving history, especially concerning the Numidia Airport, part of the US Postal Service Transcontinental Air Mail Service.

Family survivors included seven beloved children: Michael, Mary Rose, James, Frances, George Jr, Anne and Elizabeth. He had six grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren. He was also survived by two brothers and preceded in death by a brother and sister. His wife Mary Louise passed February 9, 2018.

His son Jim informed George Collister that a Celebration of Life service will be announced at a future date, very likely in June 2022, around George's birthday.


2021 PA State Rally

RALLY FEES - \$435 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$130 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you bring your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation with you to the rally.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the rally are entered into a prize drawing. Over \$2,000 in gift certificates for parts and service will be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA - In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2022. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after 8:00 pm may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY - Refund requests received by May 28th, 2022, will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests after May 29th, 2022, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after July 9th, 2022. If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance.

RALLY PARKING DATES – General parking is tentatively scheduled to begin around July 20th. Parking dates will be sent via email in Spring 2022. Caravans of 5 or more need to contact HQ at rally@airstreamclub.org for arrival date.
