October 3 – October 9, 2022, includes the Tennessee Valley Old Time Fiddlers Convention, Thursday, October 6, 2022 – Saturday, October 8, 2022, Athens, Alabama.

Rally in Athens, Alabama for the **2022 Tennessee Valley Old Time Fiddlers Convention**. Early parking for the volunteers available on October 3. The Airstream rally starts on October 4th with welcome dinner. Upon arrival, sign up for tours to area destinations. A free concert opens the convention on October 6th. The \$55 / person rally fee includes two-day convention entrance fee, and two evenings of featured performances by headliner entertainers. Competitions include playing instruments, singing and dancing. Craft and food concessions are found throughout campus. Exclusive WBAC parking includes 20 AMP power, water and one (1) pump out for \$25/night located within 3/10th mile of the main venue. Parking reservations requires four (4) night minimum. Rally attendees are also welcomed to stay at nearby RV Parks with full hook ups. Rally reservations and deposits are required by August 15. Visit
