
coordinating.



2022 Splash Rally

July 14 – 17, 2022

Howard Miller Steelhead Park, Rockport, WA



We have 30 electric and water RV sites reserved for this rally.

Arrival is Thursday, July 14. Check in with the host, set up, and happy hour at 4:30 at the pavilion. Bring your own chair and drink.

Friday, July 15, there will be a chicken dinner either at Nehalem or at the pavilion. More information on the dinner later.

Saturday, July 16, there will be a white-water trip on the Sauk River for those that sign up. We will reserve 24 spots. Happy hour will be at the pavilion at 4:30.

Sunday, July 17, depart.

The costs so far are for the RV sites for three nights are \$110 per site.

Chicken dinner, if possible, at Nehalem will be \$20 per person.

Rafting on the Sauk, price is not set yet, but 2021 price was \$85 per person.

In the first newsletter of 2022, we hope to have more information on the cost of dinner and rafting with a coupon and web site update.

You do not have to make a reservation with the park. We have reserved the 30 sites. There are cabins available for rent. If you want a cabin, you should make your reservation ASAP (after 1/1/22).

For those of you who have never attended Splash, you are in for a great rally even if you don't raft. There are lots of things to do in the area, including hiking, biking, fishing, dam tour, and road trip to Winthrop over the North Cascade Pass, or just relax and enjoy the scenery, enjoy fellowship with other Airstreamers or read a book.

Sign up fast as this rally will fill quickly. We will keep a wait list.

For those who wish to arrive early or stay longer, call the park at 360-853-8808 to reserve a site or cabin. Tell them you are in the Airstream Rally. We have sites 20-49 reserved for this rally. Leave a message if no one answers.

2022 WA Airstream Club Fishing Rally, May 10-16 Black Beach Resort, Curlew Lake, Republic, WA



We are looking forward to some great fishing, fun, exploration and relaxation! If at any time you have any questions, please call, text or email the Hosts, Paul & Charli Westerfield: charli300 7@msn.com. Cell 360-485-7837.

For those wanting to stay in one of Black Beach's cabins or duplexes, there are 16 to choose from, some are brand new! Please see the resort website for rates and rules. Prices vary from \$85 to \$149 per day (2021 rates). We have 10 beach front RV sites reserved now. We can add more if there is interest. The inland sites are a little less expensive if you would prefer away from the beach in the trees.

Even though most of us will have had our COVID vaccines and boosters, we will still likely be wearing masks and social-distancing when indoors or at restaurants. Local restaurants and other attractions will be open. Most of our activities will be outdoors, so no masks required for those!

Black Beach Resort is located at 848 Black Beach Road, Republic WA 99166. (509-775-3989). If you are driving straight through from WLYH, it is about 341 miles from the Harbor. You may wish to leave a day early and stop over at Beebe Bridge Park, arriving at Black Beach on Tuesday.

For those stopping overnight at Beebe Bridge Park, here is the address: 23459 Highway 97, Orondo, WA 98843. It is about 34 miles north of Wenatchee on 97. The RV Park is first come, first served; no reservations. It is about 214 miles from Washington Land Yacht Harbor.

We will need help putting up the big tent after you check in. It goes up quickly with many hands helping. **Keurig coffees, teas & hot chocolate available every morning**. If you have a favorite variety, bring your own. We are not planning group meals under the tent at this time, except for the final pizza dinner. However, potlucks could happen if all are comfortable with that. We may also eat some meals in Republic or at the K Diamond K Guest Ranch. They are always happy to accommodate us.

Unless otherwise notified, <u>Social Hour will be at 4:00 pm every day</u> starting May 10th at the big tent near the beach (snacks to share optional). Notifications and announcements will be made during the social hours. **Bonfire all day long!** Of course fishing is every day for those who like to wet a hook. BE SURE TO GET YOUR FISHING LICENSE FOR EASTERN WA LAKES! Boats and motors to rent are available from the resort office, as well as party boats.

There will be men's and women's prizes for biggest fish (any kind of fish, not limited to trout). Be sure to measure and record in log book with an observer all fish you want to include in your entries for biggest fish. *All official fish measuring must be done at the tent.*

Bocce Ball, Ladder Golf, possibly Corn-Hole (if you have a set, please bring it with!), and casting practice will be available; we can get up some friendly competitions if you like.

We are happy to have suggestions for things to do or games, cards to play, etc. The K Diamond K Guest Ranch is open for horseback trail riding, and great dining!

The Ferry County Rail Trail runs behind the RV Park and goes for miles in either direction. Great for bike riding or walking.

Please send in your coupon ASAP. We need to know if you are coming by March 15. The club must pay the deposit April 1. If you want to rent a cabin, call Black Beach Resort right away as they fill up fast for fishing season.


