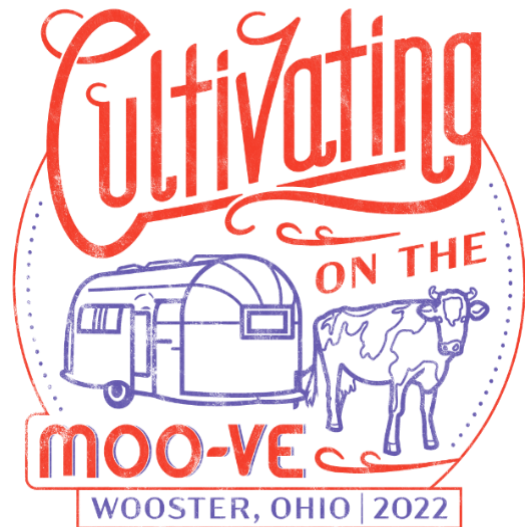

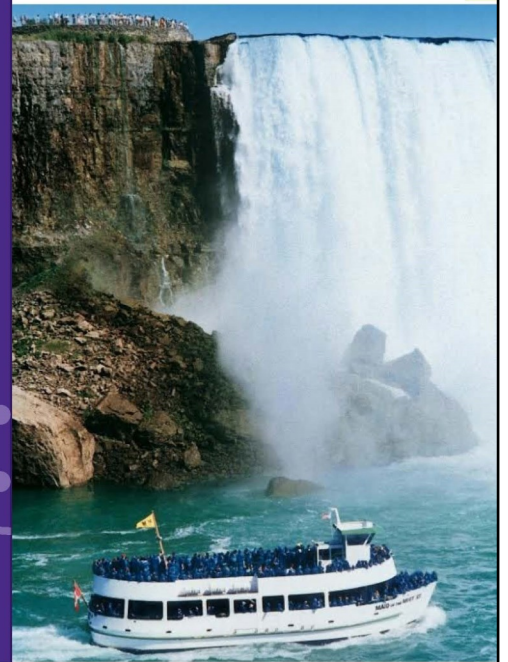

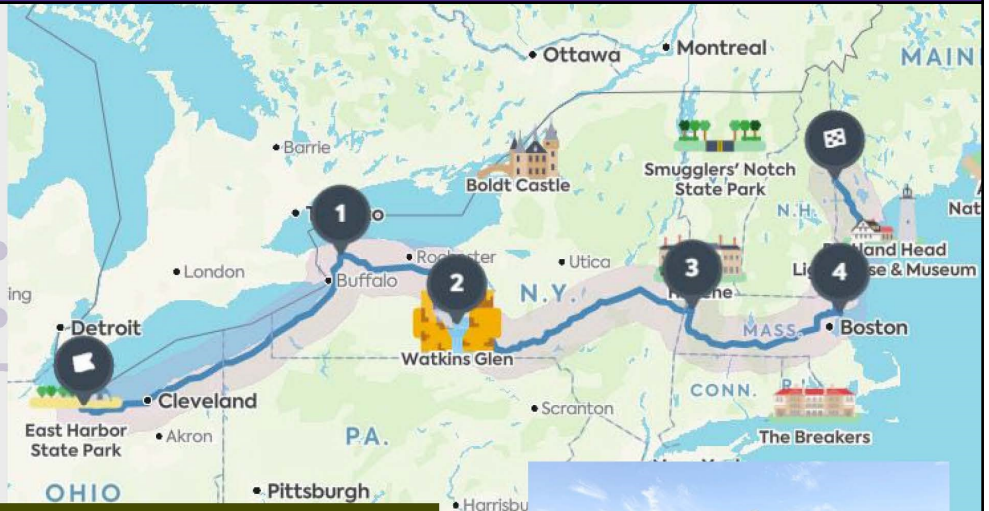

What is Amish country? Ohio has the largest Amish population in the nation, and this part of Ohio has the largest Amish community in the state. The Amish take this time of year to share their way of living with us. If you’ve not experienced this before, you’re in for a fascinating week. If you’ve been before, you know what a good time we have. This family-friendly rally includes a wide variety of tour choices and nightly entertainment, complete with door prizes.

The *Day in the Park* brings the world of the Amish to us. You don’t have to leave the campground to enjoy aspects of the Amish life.
