The Lancaster Event Center only has one dump station which is inconveniently located. It is recommended you arrive with empty waste tanks. A pump out service may be available; we are still working out details on this. We are also compiling a list of area dump locations, which may be an option on your way to or from the rally. This list will be furnished to all registered campers prior to the rally so you will have these options as you come in to Lincoln.
