Making Airstreaming Better -Upgrades and Add-Ons / Trailer

If these last two years have taught us anything, it's the freedom to travel (especially in safety and comfort) is invaluable. But it's those "little things" that can cast a dark shadow on an otherwise great trip.

Regardless of the time of year, we've had two "operator errors" that had consequences we didn't consider:

- Dry camping on a hot day, our fridge suddenly decided, "I'm now an oven" and proceeded to warm up all our perishable food while we were out!
- While winter camping with full hook ups, in the middle of a 14F night, our furnace just stopped heating. While the electric space heaters saved our butts (the AC heat pump does nothing at those temps) the water tanks lost all protection - we were lucky only the dump valves froze!

The cause of both issues? We'd run out of propane!

Now it's easy and simple to take those 5-gallon tanks and pick them up to see how full they are (Tip - Costco currently offers them with an exterior gauge!!!). But the two in out trailer are HUGE...and under a cover....and bolted down.

Well, we discovered there really is "an app for that" - in this case a device that works with your phone! <u>Mopeka Tank</u> <u>Check</u>, offers you a simple magnetic "reader" disk you put on the bottom of each tank. We named ours "Curb Side" & "Driver Side". After setting up the app, just opening it up told us:

- What percentage of "full" each tank was.
- How recently that reading had been taken.
- The condition of the small watch size battery.
- How strong the signal was for determining the tank volume.

The Good

- No need to pick up, shake or otherwise move your tank.
- You can now check your tanks from the trailer or your truck while moving!
- The system is "always on" so long as you are within range of the sensors. Just open the app!
- You can monitor multiple tanks so your BBQ, fire pit or any other home or Airstream, can be added!

The Bad

- Yes, you'll have to pay around \$100 for the sensors depending on if your tanks are steel or aluminum.
- The batteries at some point will have to be replaced (ours lasted about a year and a half).
- The sensors are only held on by their magnetic connection, so you could accidently knock one off if you are moving your tanks around.
- It further cements the fact your cell phone is now a part of your everyday life!

We've personally tested this out for over a year, and it works flawlessly!

Of particular interest to Airstreamers, the festival will feature another chance to see the documentary, Alumination, on February 20 at 5:30pm. A deep dive into how Airstream became a legendary American brand, with extensive archival footage, interwoven with modern-day Airstream events and narrated by Kate Pierson of rock band The B-52s.
